**PROGRESS REPORT
2001 POPULATION AND HOUSING CENSUS
ST.KITTS AND NEVIS**

During the past twelve months the Statistics Division, St. Kitts has been actively involved in three main activities related to the Census, namely:

- Coding and editing of remaining questionnaires
- Verification of data
- Post Scanning

At this point in time, the initial scanning of the data has been done for St. Kitts, and the final post scan using IMPS is ongoing. All of this has been achieved despite a number of mitigating factors.

We wish to express our thanks to the CARICOM Secretariat and to Mr. Gordon who has been tireless in his efforts to ensure that we remain focused and complete activities under the Census as soon as possible. We have benefited from the assistance of CELADE through Mr. Serge Poulard who has been of tremendous help to us, we also wish to express our gratitude to him. In the area of training, we also benefited when one of the key officers received training in the Post Scanning Process at ECLAC's office in Trinidad.

The next phase of the project will involve the tabulation of the data. In the interim, we have been deriving some tables using SPSS. (Some sample tables are attached). The data is still preliminary but it is hoped that in the next couple of weeks we will have a clean data set for St Kitts.

Nevis, meanwhile, has begun the scanning process this past week. CARICOM through Mr. Edwin St. Catherine provided some technical assistance to Nevis to start the process. It is our hope that the scanning and post scanning processes can be completed on Nevis as soon as possible so that a whole picture of the Federation can be obtained.
