The Caribbean Community (CARICOM) Secretariat by Savingram No. 647/2006 dated 9 August 2006 informed Member States of the convening of the Thirty-First Meeting of the Standing Committee of Caribbean Statisticians (SCCS) and the Fourteenth Meeting of the Regional Census Coordinating Committee (RCCC) on **6 – 8** and **9 - 10 November 2006**, respectively. The Secretariat now wishes to confirm that the venue of the Meeting will be the **Crowne Plaza Hotel, Port-of Spain, Trinidad and Tobago**.
2. Accommodation for delegations to the Meeting has been arranged at the **Crowne Plaza** at a rate of **US\$187.55** single occupancy and **\$205.70** double occupancy per night, *inclusive* of breakfast, taxes and internet. Alternative accommodation has also been arranged at the **Hilton Hotel** at a rate of **US\$130** single occupancy and **US\$140** double occupancy *inclusive* of breakfast, *exclusive* of taxes and at the Courtyard by Marriott **US\$187.55** single and double occupancy, *inclusive* of breakfast and taxes.
3. Member States are reminded to forward to the Secretariat, the name(s) and designation(s) of the members of their respective delegations no later than **Friday, 6 October 2006**.
