Intra-CARICOM Trade

CARICOM'S INTRA-REGIONAL TRADE – 1996 - 2001

During the period 1996 – 2001, CARICOM's intra-regional imports expanded from EC\$2.1 billion in 1996 to EC\$2.8 billion in 2001 (ten Member States reporting in both cases) at an average annual growth rate of 6.2% over the period. CARICOM's intra-regional exports advanced from EC\$2.4 billion in 1996 (eleven Member States reporting) to EC\$3.4 billion in 2001 (ten Member States reporting) at an average annual growth rate of 7.8% over the period.

CARICOM's intra-regional imports as a percentage of its imports from all sources increased marginally from 10.0% in 1996 to 10.8% in 2001 with its highest percentage contribution of 11.6% being recorded in 1999. CARICOM's intra-regional exports as a percentage of its total exports to all destinations increased from 16.8% in 1996 and 20.4% in 2001 (**Tables 2.12.2 and 2.12.4**).

Major Contributors

Throughout the period, 1996 -2001, CARICOM's intra-regional imports were dominated by the MDCs with an average percentage contribution of 74.0%. Imports of the MDCs' from the Region expanded from EC\$1.5 billion in 1996 (four of five Member States reporting) to EC\$2.0 billion in 2001 (three of five Member States reporting), which accounted for 71.7% in 1996 and 73.0% in 2001 of CARICOM's intra-regional imports. The LDCs' intra-regional imports also expanded from EC\$0.6 billion in 1996 (six Member States reporting) to EC\$0.7 billion in 2001 (seven Member States reporting), which represented 28.3% (1996) and 27.0% (2001) of CARICOM's intra-regional exports (**Table 2.12.2**).

The MDCs also dominated CARICOM's intra-regional exports with an average percentage contribution of 91.9% over the period. The MDCs' exports to the Region moved from EC\$2.2 billion in 1996 (four of five Member States reporting) to EC\$3.2 billion in 2001 (three of five Member States reporting), which accounted for 91.8% in 1996 and 92.8% in 2001 of CARICOM's total intra-regional exports. The LDCs intra-regional exports stood at EC\$0.2 billion in 1996 and 2001 which represented 8.2% in 1996 to 7.2% in 2001 of CARICOM's total intra-regional exports (**Table 2.12.4**).

During the period, 1996-2001, *Jamaica* and *Barbados* were CARICOM's top intra-regional importers. *Jamaica's* imports from the Region increased from EC\$0.8 billion in 1996 to EC\$1.2 billion in 2001 which accounted for 37.8% and 42.1% of CARICOM's intra-regional imports in these respective

years. *Barbados*' intra-regional imports moved from EC\$0.3 billion in 1996 to EC\$0.6 billion in 2001, which represented 16.3% and 21.2% of CARICOM's intra-regional imports. Collectively these two Member States accounted for an average percentage contribution of 53.2% of CARICOM's total intra-regional over the period (**Table 2.12.2**).

With regards to intra-regional exports, *Trinidad and Tobago* and *Barbados* were CARICOM's leading intra-regional exporters. *Trinidad and Tobago*'s intra-regional exports advanced from EC\$1.7 billion in 1996 to EC\$2.8 billion in 2001, which accounted for 71.5% and 80.4% respectively of the Region's intra-regional exports. *Barbados*' intra-regional exports stood at EC\$0.3 billion in 1996 and 2001, which represented 11.5% and 8.5% respectively of CARICOM's intra-regional exports. The combined percentage contributions of these two Member States accounted for an average percentage contribution of 82.1% of CARICOM's intra-regional exports, over the period (**Table 2.12.4**).

Intra-Regional Trading Partners

Total Intra – Regional Imports

1996

In this year, all CARICOM Member States (*except Belize*) sourced more than 50% of their intra-regional imports from *Trinidad and Tobago*. *Trinidad and Tobago*'s contribution was most significant in the intra-regional imports of *Jamaica* and *Suriname* where it accounted for 84.5% (EC\$0.7 billion) and 82.9% (EC\$0.1 billion) of their intra-regional imports.

Belize's intra-regional imports were dominated by *Jamaica* and *Trinidad and Tobago*. These Member States accounted for 41.4% (EC\$12 million) and 37.7% (EC\$11 million) respectively of *Belize*'s intra-regional imports in 1996 (**Tables 2.12.5a (i) & (ii)**).

1998

Trinidad and Tobago maintained its position as the top intra-regional source of imports for CARICOM Member States in this year. Its contribution was most significant in the intra-regional imports of *Barbados*, *Guyana* and *Grenada* where it accounted for 80.3% (EC\$0.4 billion), 79.4% (EC\$0.2 billion) and 79.4% (EC\$0.1 billion) of their intra-regional imports (**Tables 2.12.5 c (i) & (ii)**).

2000

In 2000, *Trinidad and Tobago* continued to be the major source of the intra-regional imports of all Member States (*except Montserrat*). In this year its contribution was most significant in the intra-regional imports of *Barbados* and *Guyana* where it accounted for 82.9% (EC\$0.5 billion) and 84.9% (EC\$0.2 billion) of their intra-regional imports.

St. Kitts and Nevis dominated *Montserrat's* intra-regional imports and accounted for 44.2% (EC\$5 million) of *Montserrat's* intra-regional imports in 2000 (**Tables 2.12.5e (i) & (ii)**)

2001

For 2001, *Trinidad and Tobago* continued to dominate the intra-regional imports of all CARICOM Member States. In this year, *Trinidad and Tobago* was most significant in the intra-regional imports of *Jamaica* where it represented 82.7% (EC\$1.0 billion) of *Jamaica's* intra-regional imports (**Tables 2.12.5f (i) & (ii)**).

Total Intra-regional exports

Over the period 1996 – 2001, *Jamaica and Trinidad and Tobago* were the major destinations for most Member States.

1996

In 1996, *Jamaica* topped the intra-regional exports of *Barbados* (25.0% or 68 million), *Dominica* (44.6% or 29 million) and *Trinidad and Tobago* (35.3% or 596 million) while *Trinidad and Tobago* was the top intra-regional destination for *Jamaica* (32.0% or EC\$46 million), *Suriname* (56.2% or EC\$36 million) and *Belize* (47.5% or 6 million) (**Tables 2.12.5a (iii) & (iv)**).

1998

For 1998, *Jamaica* was the top intra-regional destination for *Guyana* (44.5% or EC\$61 million) and *Belize* (46.1% or EC\$14 million). This Member State also maintained its top position in the intra-regional exports of *Trinidad and Tobago and Dominica* with contributions to 32.5% (EC\$647 million) and 43.6% (EC\$40 million) of their intra-regional exports.

In this year, *Trinidad and Tobago* was the top intra-regional destination for *Barbados, Jamaica, Saint Lucia and St. Vincent and the Grenadines* and accounted for 25.0%, 37.2%, 29.7% and 22.4% of their intra-regional exports (**Tables 2.12.5c (iii) & (iv)**).

2000

Jamaica maintained its position as the top intra-regional destination for *Guyana, Belize, Dominica and Trinidad and Tobago* with respective percentage contributions of 41.9% (EC\$76 million), 54.4% (EC\$13 million), 41.7% (EC\$35 million) and 34.7% (EC\$912 million).

For 2000, *Trinidad and Tobago* continued to be the major intra-regional destination for *Barbados, Jamaica and St. Vincent and the Grenadines* and accounted for 30.6% and 44.2% and 20.9% respectively of their intra-regional exports. It was also the top the intra-regional destination of *St Kitts and Nevis* with percentage contribution of 31.8% (**Tables 2.12.5e (iii) & (iv)**).

2001

For 2001, *Jamaica* was the top destination for *Trinidad and Tobago and Dominica* and represented 35.2% (EC\$973 million) and 38.7% (EC\$27 million) of these Member States intra-regional exports.

In this year, *Trinidad and Tobago* was the top intra-regional destination for *Belize and Grenada* and accounted for 48.1% and 20.4% of their intra-regional exports. This Member State continued to be the main intra-regional destination for *Barbados, Jamaica and St. Vincent and the Grenadines* and represented 26.6%, 42.6% and 31.7% of their intra-regional exports (**Tables 2.12.5f (iii) & (iv)**).

Major Commodities

Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials and *Food* dominated CARICOM's intra-regional trade throughout the period 1996 – 2001 (**Tables 12.6 & 12.8**).

Imports

Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials were the highest imported commodities throughout the period with percentage contributions moving from 38.9% in 1996 to 32.9% in 1998. In 1999 and 2000 the percentage contribution of these commodities strengthened to 38.3% and 46.5% respectively and marginally declined to 45.0% in 2001.

CARICOM's second highest imported commodity over the period was *Food*. The percentage contribution of this commodity improved from 17.4% in 1996 to 21.9% in 1998. In 1999 and 2000, its percentage contribution declined to 19.8% and 18.5% respectively but strengthened to 19.8% in 2001.

Exports

For CARICOM's intra-regional exports, *Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials* were the highest exported commodities within the Region. The percentage contribution of these products to CARICOM's intra-regional exports moved from 36.6% in 1996 to 29.0% in 1998 and thereafter increased to 38.4%, 47.8% and 49.3% in 1999, 2000 and 2001 respectively. For 1996, the second highest exported intra-regional commodity was *Manufactured Goods* with percentage contribution of 17.5%. However from 1997 – 2001, *Food* was the second major commodity exported intra-regionally but with declining percentage contributions from 20.8% in 1997 to 14.2% in 2001.

MOVEMENTS IN THE MDCs AND LDCs CONTRIBUTION TO INTRA-REGIONAL IMPORTS: 1996-2001

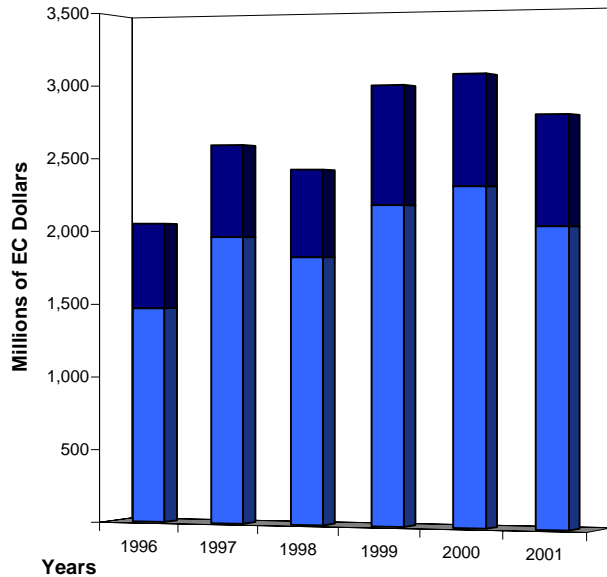


FIGURE 2.12.2

MOVEMENT IN THE MDCs AND LDCs CONTRIBUTION TO INTRA-REGIONAL EXPORTS: 1996-2001

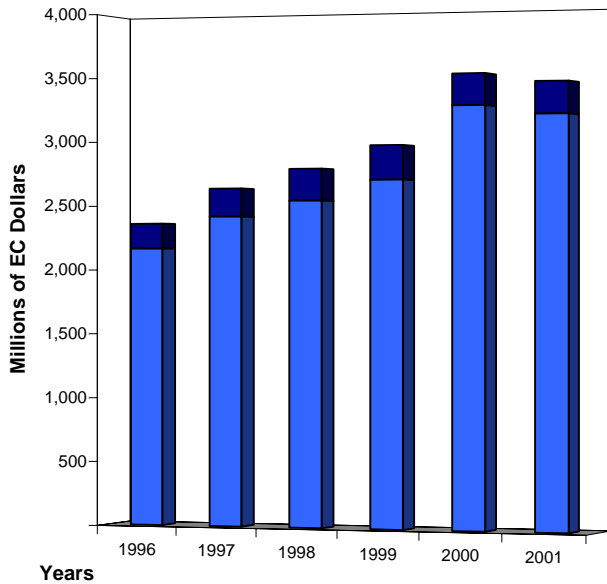

DISTRIBUTION OF CARICOM'S INTRA-REGIONAL IMPORTS, BY PRINCIPAL SITC SECTIONS: 1996

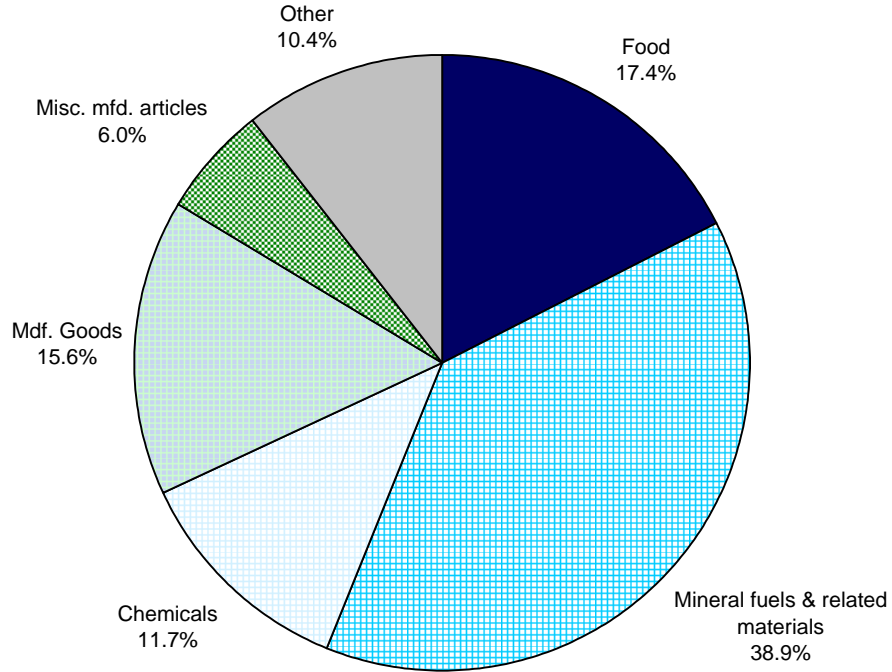
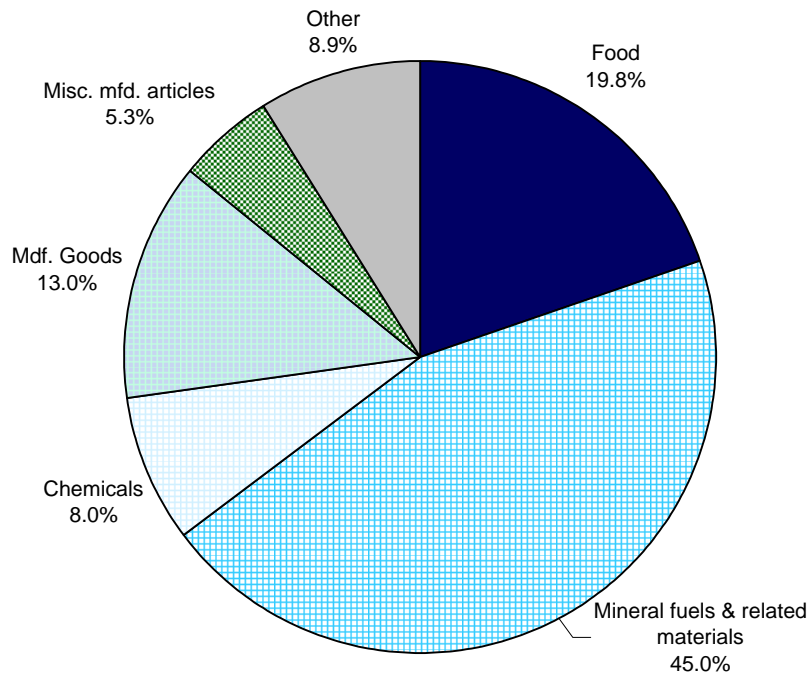


FIGURE 2.12.4

DISTRIBUTION OF CARICOM'S INTRA-REGIONAL EXPORTS, BY PRINCIPAL SITC SECTIONS: 1996

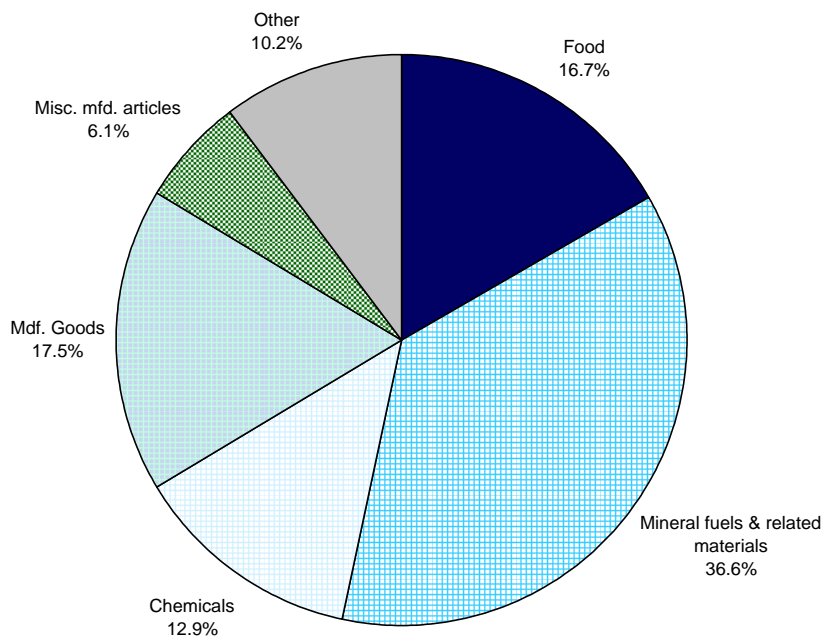


FIGURE 2.12.6
