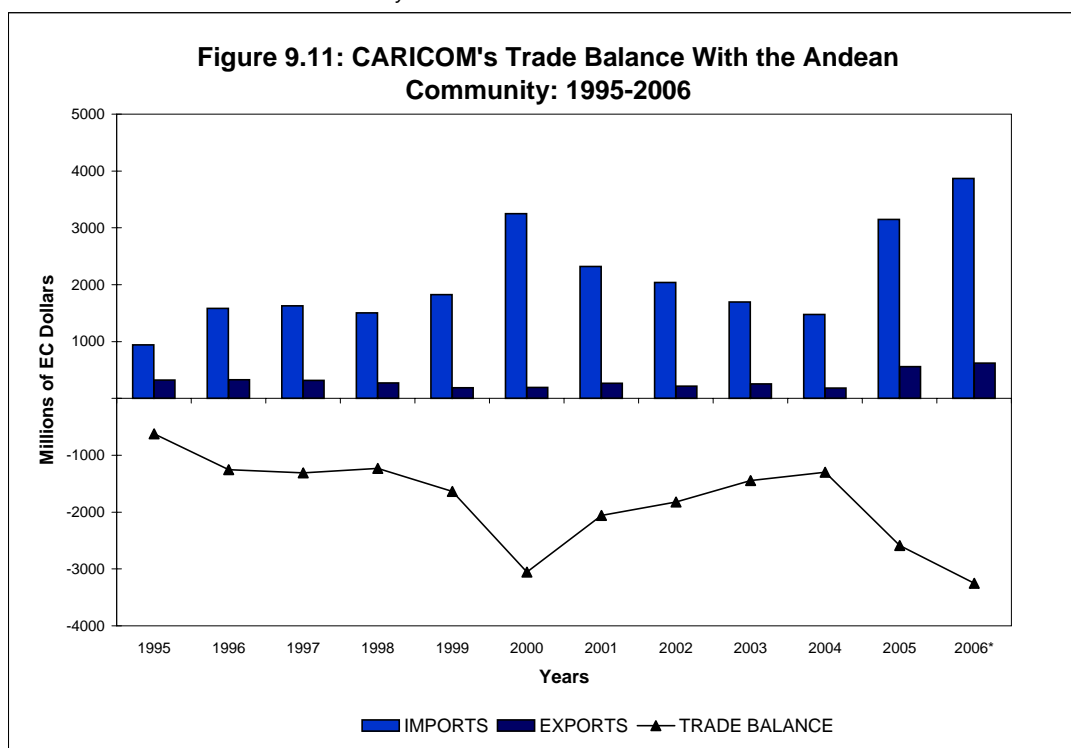

Figure 9.12: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Imports from The Andean Community: 2001

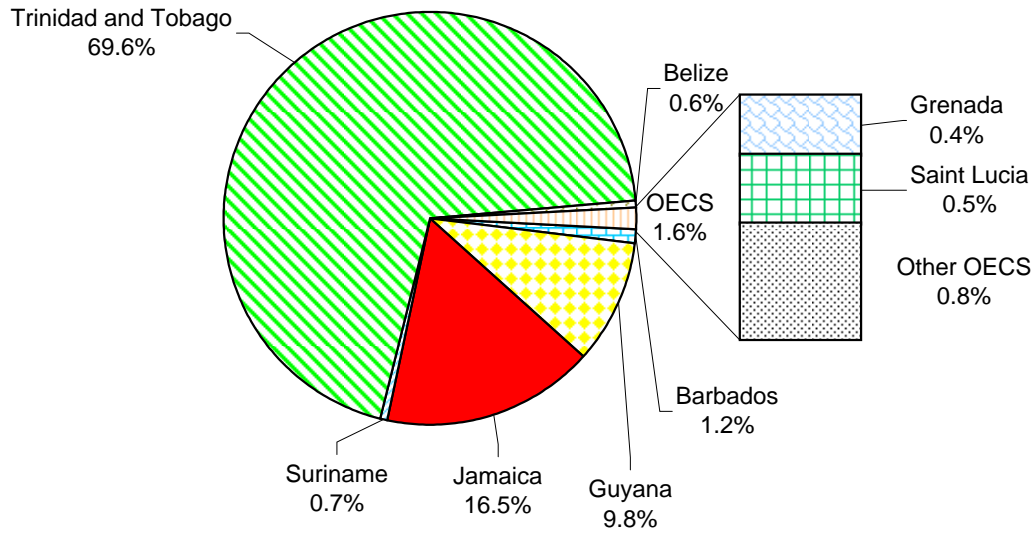


Figure 9.13: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Imports from The Andean Community: 2006

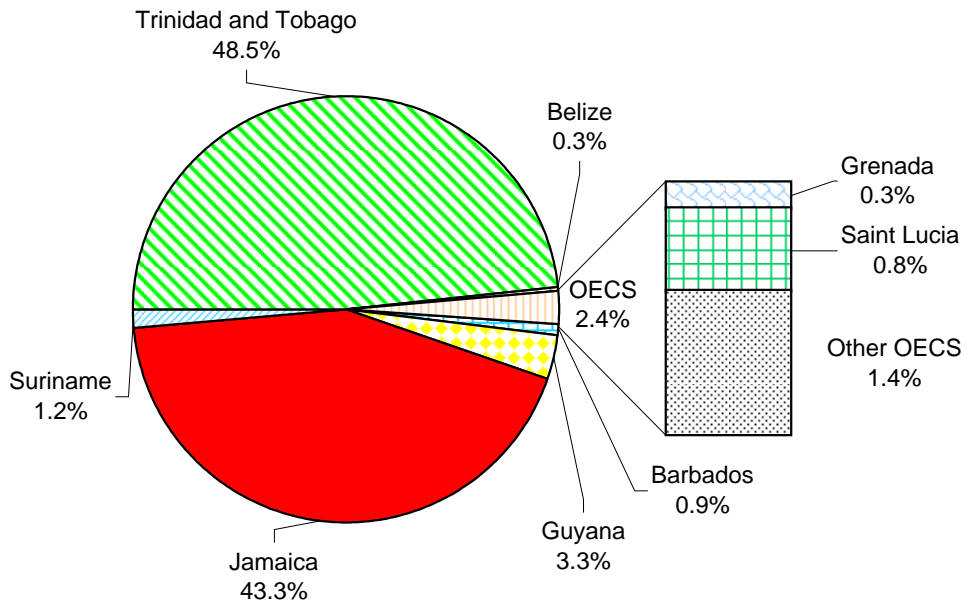

Figure 9.14: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Total Exports to the Andean Community: 2001

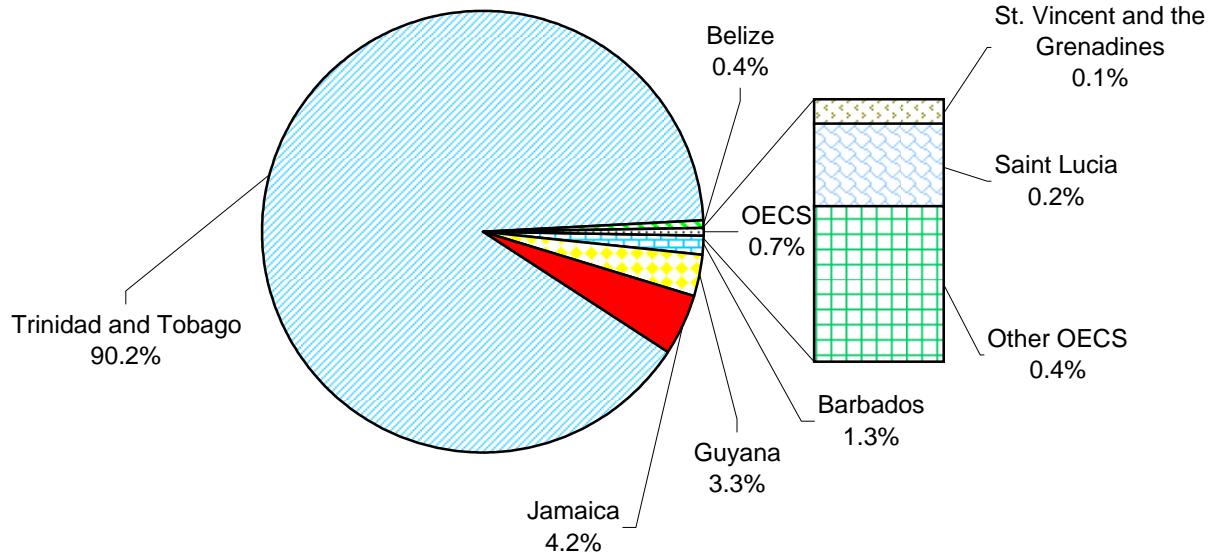


Figure 9.15: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Total Exports to the Andean Community: 2006

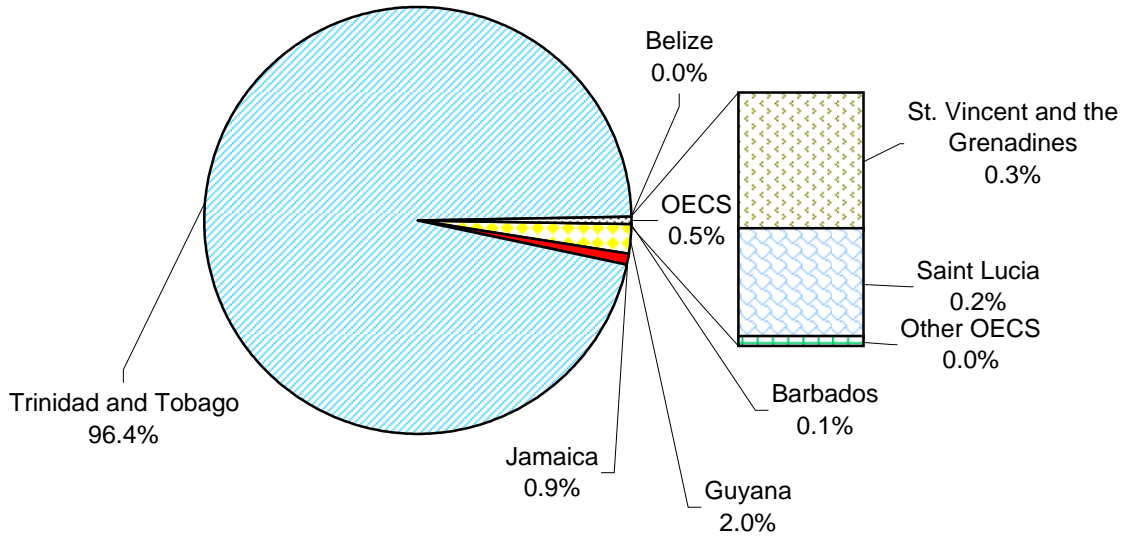

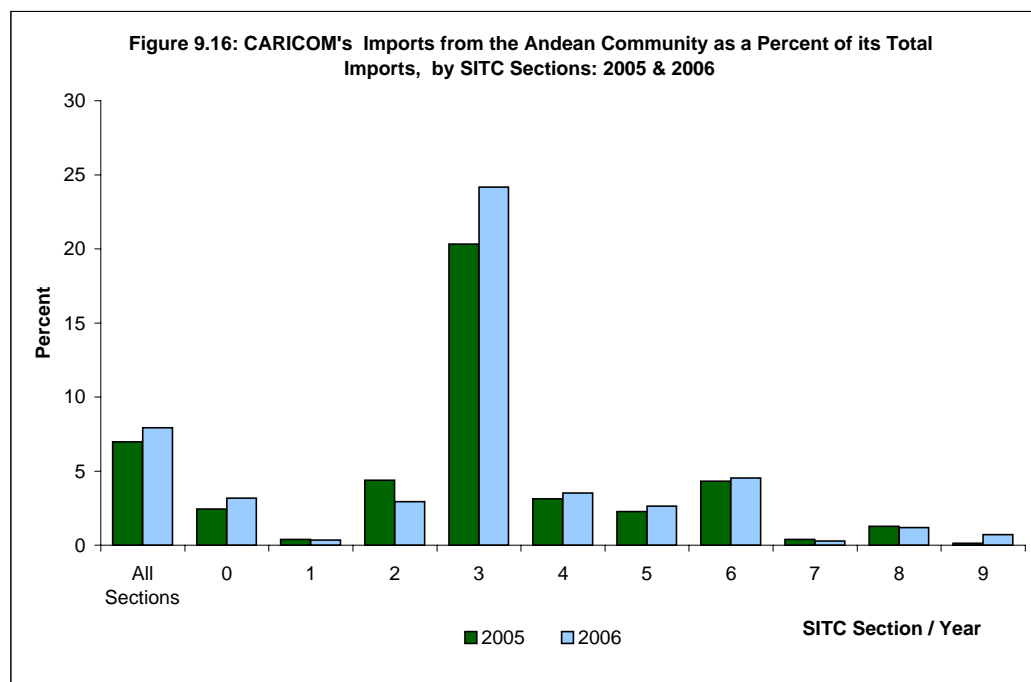

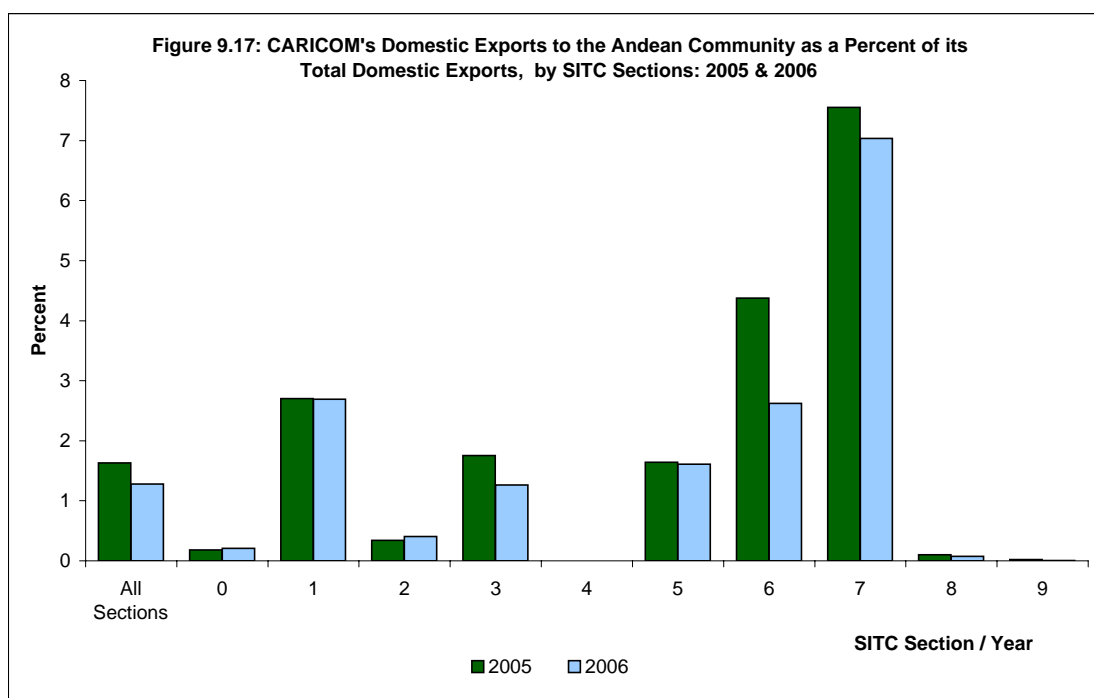
