

CARICOM'S INTRA-REGIONAL TRADE¹ : 2001 - 2006

Over the period, 2001-2006, CARICOM's intra-regional imports increased from EC\$3.3 Bn (US\$1.2 Bn) in 2001² to EC\$6.1 Bn (US\$2.3 Bn) in 2006³ at an average annual growth rate of *13.2 percent*. Intra-Regional imports in 2006 represented a decrease of EC\$0.1 Bn (US\$41 Mn) or *1.8 percent* as compared to the value in 2005³. CARICOM's intra-regional exports also expanded moving from EC\$3.6 Bn (US\$1.3 Bn) in 2001⁴ to EC\$7.9 Bn (US\$2.9 Bn) in 2006⁴ at an average annual growth rate of *16.7 percent*. In 2006, intra-regional exports increased by *18.8 percent* or EC\$1.2 Bn (US\$0.5 Bn) over the 2005² value (**Table 2.1**).

CARICOM's total imports from all sources also increased over the period moving from EC\$28.6 Bn (US\$10.6 Bn) in 2001² to EC\$45.1 Bn (US\$16.7 Bn) in 2005³ and EC\$48.8 Bn (US\$18.1 Bn) in 2006³. CARICOM's intra-regional imports as a percentage of its total imports from all sources on average represented *12.3 percent* moving from *11.6 percent* in 2001 to *13.9 percent* and *12.6 percent* in 2005 and 2006 respectively. For the major categories of commodities, *beverages and tobacco* reflected the highest percentage contribution of intra-regional imports to total imports with an average of *47.0 percent* over the period. This was followed by *mineral fuels, lubricants and related material* and *food* which reflected average percentage contributions of intra-regional imports to total imports of *28.7 percent* and *16.0 percent* respectively (**Tables 2.3 and 2.9**).

On the exports side, the Region's total exports to all destinations expanded from EC\$18.2 Bn (US\$6.7 Bn) in 2001⁴ to EC\$34.3 Bn (US\$12.7 Bn) in 2005² and EC\$48.4 Bn (US\$17.9 Bn) in 2006⁴. As a percentage of total exports to all destinations, total intra-regional exports on average represented *17.2 percent* over the period moving from *20 percent* in 2001 to *19.3 percent* and *16.3 percent* in 2005 and 2006 respectively. For the major categories of commodities, total intra-regional exports of *animal and vegetable oils, fats and waxes* on average represented *89.4 percent* of the Region's total exports of this category. Intra-regional exports of *miscellaneous manufactured articles* and *beverages and tobacco* on average accounted for *40.6 percent* and *39.7 percent* of the CARICOM's total exports of these

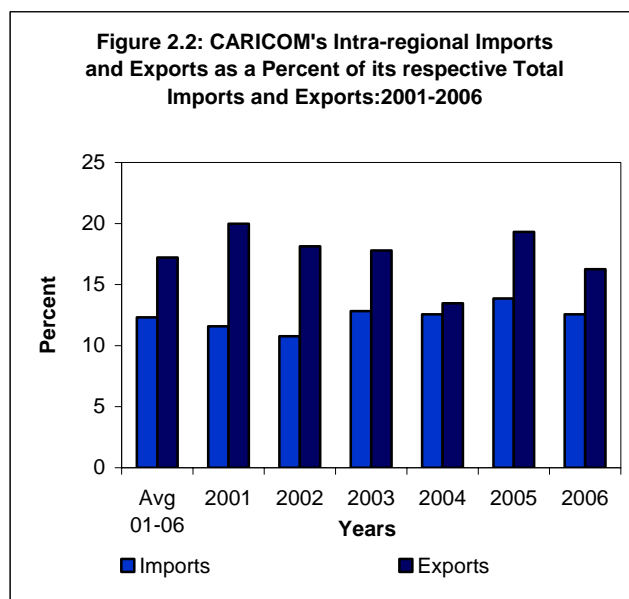
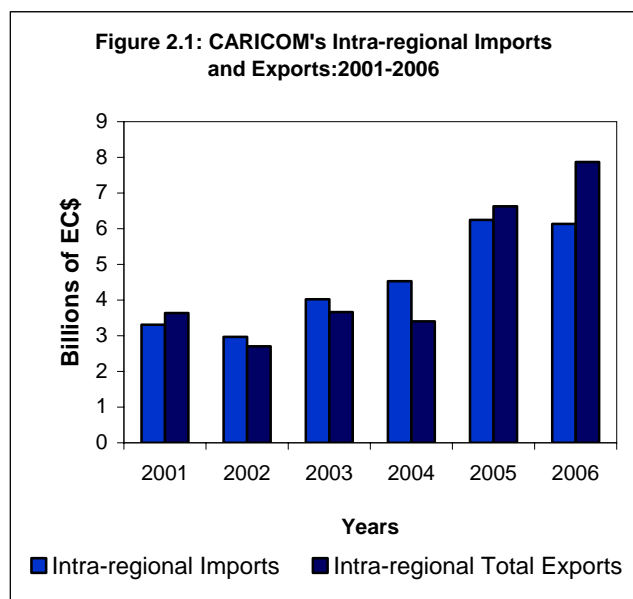

respective categories. These categories on average reflected the highest percentage contributions of total intra-regional exports to CARICOM’s total exports to all destinations (**Tables 2.5 and 2.11**).



Major Contributors – MDCs, LDCs and Member States

Imports

Throughout the period, 2001-2006, the MDCs dominated CARICOM’s intra-regional imports accounting for an average percentage contribution of *80.1 percent* over the period. The MDCs’ intra-regional imports expanded from EC\$2.6 Bn (US\$0.9 Bn) in 2001⁵ to EC\$4.7 Bn (US\$1.8 Bn) in 2006⁵ at an average annual growth rate of *13.1 percent*. The percentage contribution of the MDCs to total intra-regional imports moved *77.4 percent* in 2001 and *77.1 percent* in 2006. For 2005-2006, the MDCs intra-regional imports decreased from EC\$5.0 Bn (US\$1.9 Bn) in 2005 to EC\$4.7 Bn (US\$1.8 Bn) in 2006 representing annual growth rate of *-5.8 percent*.

The LDCs’ intra-regional imports also expanded moving from EC\$0.7 Bn (US\$0.3 Bn) in 2001⁶ to EC\$1.4 Bn (US\$0.5 Bn) in 2006⁷ at an average annual growth rate of *13.4 percent*. The LDCs’ imports in 2006 represented an increase of EC\$0.2 Bn (US\$65.9 Mn) or *14.5 percent* over the 2005 value. As

a percentage of CARICOM's intra-regional imports, the LDCs on average accounted for *19.9 percent* over the period.

Jamaica and *Barbados* were CARICOM's top intra-regional importers representing average percentage contributions of *33.8 percent* and *18.6 percent* respectively. *Jamaica's* intra-regional imports increased from EC\$1.2 Bn (US\$0.4 Bn) in 2001 to EC\$1.8 Bn (US\$0.7 Bn) in 2006. The percentage contributions of *Jamaica* to CARICOM's intra-regional imports were *35.3 percent* in 2001 and *29.5 percent* in 2006. *Barbados'* intra-regional imports also expanded, from EC\$0.6 Bn (US\$0.2 Bn) in 2001 to EC\$1.2 Bn (US\$0.4 Bn) in 2006, which represented *17.8 percent* and *18.9 percent* respectively of total intra-regional imports. Together these two Member States on average accounted for *52.4 percent* of total intra-regional imports over the period.

Apart from *Trinidad and Tobago* and *Belize*, all Member States showed positive average annual growth rates for 2001-2006. *Montserrat, Guyana and Suriname* reflected the highest average growth rates of *27.7 percent, 23.7 percent and 22.1 percent* respectively. The average growth rates of *Trinidad and Tobago* and *Belize* stood at *-0.4 percent* and *-9.1 percent* respectively (**Table 2.3**).

Exports

The MDCs also dominated CARICOM's intra-regional exports with an average percentage contribution of *93.5 percent*. The MDCs' intra-regional exports increased from EC\$3.4 Bn (US\$1.3 Bn) in 2001⁸ to EC\$7.5 Bn (US\$2.8 Bn) in 2006⁸ at an average annual growth rate of *17.2 percent*. In 2006, intra-regional exports of the MDCs increased by EC\$1.3 Bn (US\$0.5 Bn) or *20.3 percent* over the 2005⁸ value.

Total intra-regional exports of the LDCs' increased from EC\$0.2 Bn (US\$92 Mn) in 2001⁶ to approximately EC\$0.4 Bn (US\$148 Mn) yearly in 2005⁷ and 2006⁶ at an average annual growth rate of *8.9 percent* over the period. The percentage contributions of the LDCs to CARICOM's intra-regional exports were *6.8 percent* in 2001, *6.0 percent* in 2005 and *4.8 percent* in 2006.

With regards to the performance of Member States, *Trinidad and Tobago* was CARICOM's leading exporter. *Trinidad and Tobago's* intra-regional exports advanced from EC\$2.8 Bn (US\$1.0 Bn) in

2001 to EC\$6.6 Bn (US\$2.4 Bn) in 2006 at an average annual growth rate of 19.0 percent. In 2006, the exports of this Member State expanded by 21.6 percent or EC\$1.2 Mn (US\$0.4 Bn) over the 2005 value. Further, *Trinidad and Tobago* on average represented 78.1 percent of CARICOM's intra-regional exports for the period under review. Its percentage contributions to the Region's intra-regional exports were 76.0 percent in 2001, 82.0 percent in 2005 and 83.9 percent in 2006.

Further, all Member States reflected positive average annual growth rates. The highest average annual rates were recorded by *Saint Lucia* (25.5 percent), *St. Kitts and Nevis* (21.3 percent) and *Trinidad and Tobago* (19.0 percent). *Guyana* reflected an average annual growth rate of 11.2 percent while the remaining Member States recorded average annual growth rates of less than 8.0 percent (Table 2.5).

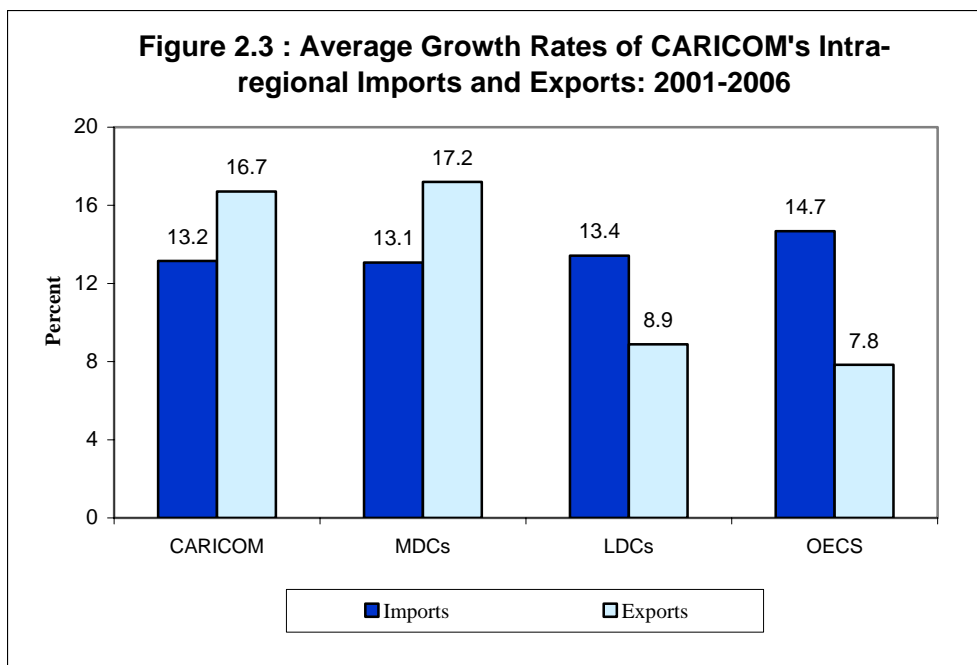


Figure 2.4: Average Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Intra-Regional Imports over the period, 2001-2006, by Country

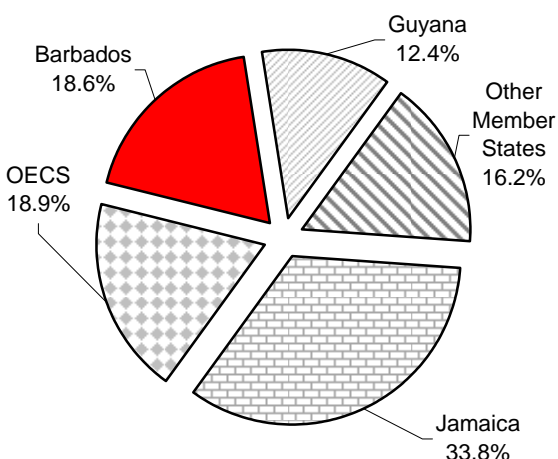
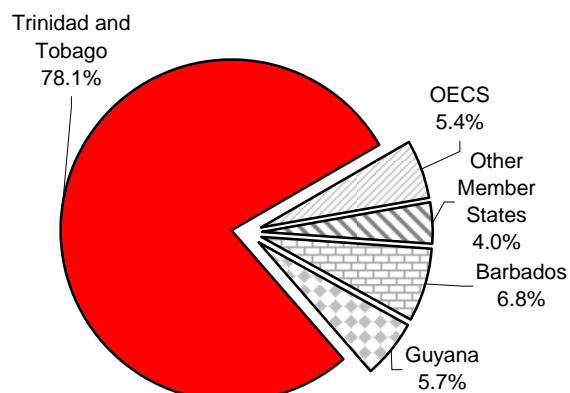


Figure 2.5: Average Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Intra-Regional Exports over the period, 2001-2006, by Country



Major Commodities⁹

Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials and *Food* were CARICOM's top two intra-regional imports and exports throughout the period, 2001–2006 (Tables 2.6 & 2.8).

Imports¹⁰

Total intra-regional imports of *Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials* increased from EC\$1.4 Bn (US\$0.5 Bn) in 2001 to EC\$3.8 Bn (US\$1.4 Bn) in 2005 and decreased to EC\$3.7 Bn (US\$1.4 Bn) in 2006. Overall these commodities on average represented 54.0 percent of total intra-regional imports moving from 43.7 percent in 2001 to 61.6 percent in 2005 and 59.8 percent in 2006.

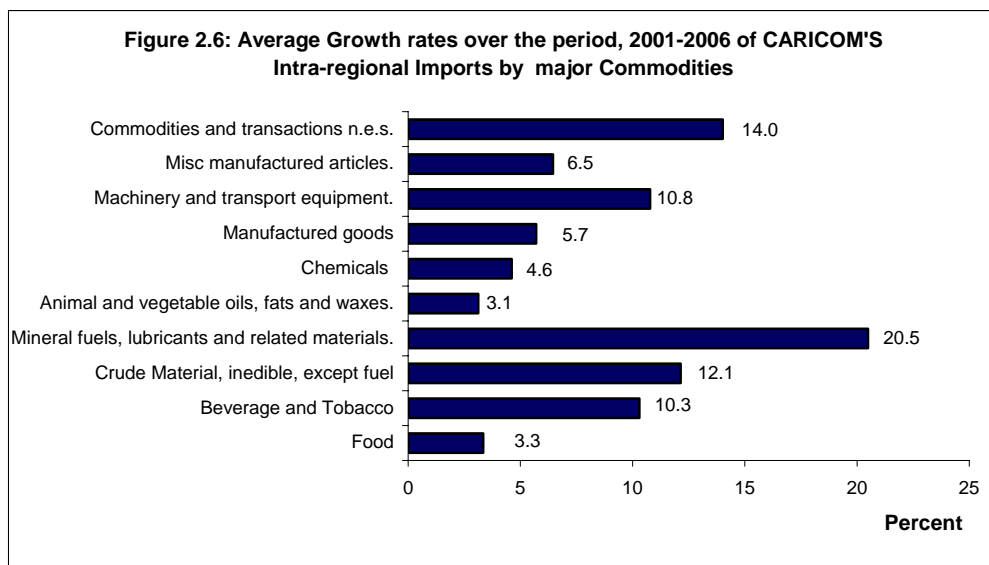
CARICOM's intra-regional imports of *Food* expanded from EC\$0.6 Bn (US\$0.2 Bn) in 2001 to approximately EC\$0.7 Bn (US\$0.3 Bn) yearly in 2005 and 2006. These commodities on average accounted for 14.3 percent of total intra-regional imports with percentage contributions decreasing from 18.6 percent in 2001 to 11.7 percent in 2005 and increasing marginally to 11.8 percent in 2006.

Average Growth rates of Major Commodities:

Overall, for the period under review, imports of all the major categories of commodities experienced positive average annual growth rates. *Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials* showed the highest average annual growth rate, *20.5 percent*. *Crude minerals, inedible, except fuel* reflected an average annual growth rate of *12.1 percent* and *machinery and transport equipment* recorded *10.8 percent*. *Food* reflected an average annual growth rate of *3.3 percent* (**Table 2.6**).



Exports¹¹

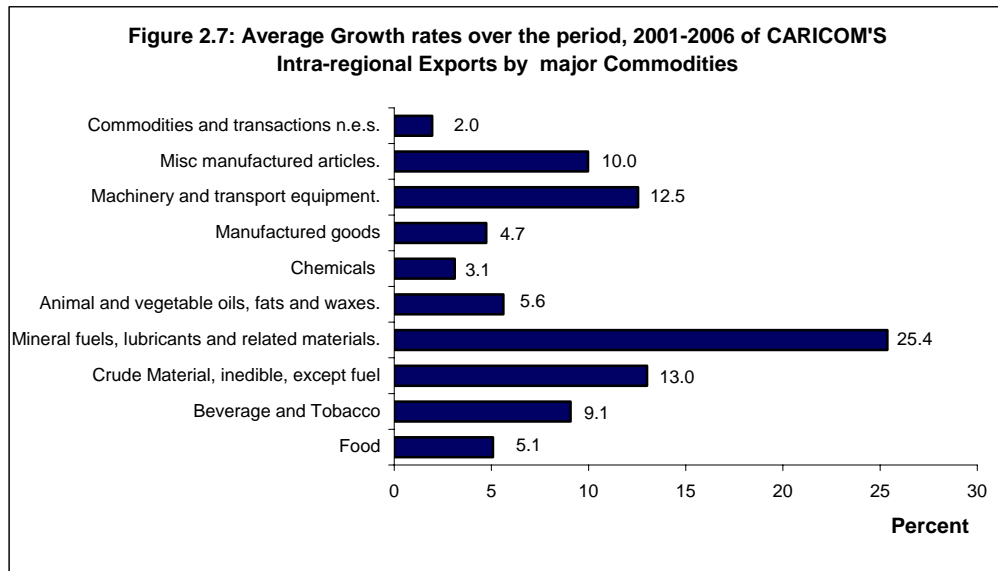
CARICOM's intra-regional exports of *Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials* were EC\$1.7 Bn (US\$0.6 Bn) in 2001 as compared to EC\$ 4.2 Bn (US\$1.5 Bn) in 2005 and EC\$5.2 Bn (US\$1.9 Bn) in 2006. As a percentage of total intra-regional exports these commodities on average represented *54.3 percent*. In 2001, the percentage contribution of these commodities to CARICOM's intra-regional exports was *46.6 percent* compared to *63.0 percent* in 2005, and *66.7 percent* in 2006.

Total intra-regional exports of *Food* expanded from EC\$0.6 Bn (US\$0.2 Bn) in 2001 to EC\$0.7 Bn (US\$0.3 Bn) and EC\$0.8 Bn (US\$0.3 Bn) in 2005 and 2006 respectively. The percentage contributions of these commodities to total intra-regional exports were *17.1 percent* in 2001, *11.1 percent* in 2005 and *10.1 percent* 2006. Intra-regional exports of *Food* on average represented *14.5 percent* of total intra-regional exports between 2001 and 2006.

Average Growth rates of Major Commodities:

Exports of all of the major commodities experienced positive average annual growth rates between 2001 and 2006. *Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials* showed the highest average annual growth rate, *25.4 percent*, followed by *Crude materials, inedible, except fuel*, *13.0 percent* and *Machinery and transport equipment*, *12.5 percent*. *Food* reflected an average annual growth rate of *5.1 percent* (Table 2.8).



Top Intra-regional Items traded

Imports

CARICOM's top ten intra-regional imports in 2006 accounted for *59.7 percent* of its total intra-regional imports. Over the period, 2003-2006, these commodities on average of represented *56.2 percent* of CARICOM's total intra-regional imports. Of the top ten intra-regional imports, the first five commodities in 2006 were:

- *Motor sprit (gasoline) (EC\$1,048.2 Mn);*
- *Diesel oil (EC\$866.1 Mn);*
- *Bunker 'C' grade fuel (EC\$723.7 Mn);*
- *Gas oils (other than diesel oil (EC\$312.2 Mn); and*
- *Kerosene type jet fuel (EC\$278.2 Mn)*

Collectively these top five commodities represented 52.6 percent of CARICOM's Intra-regional imports (Table 2.12).

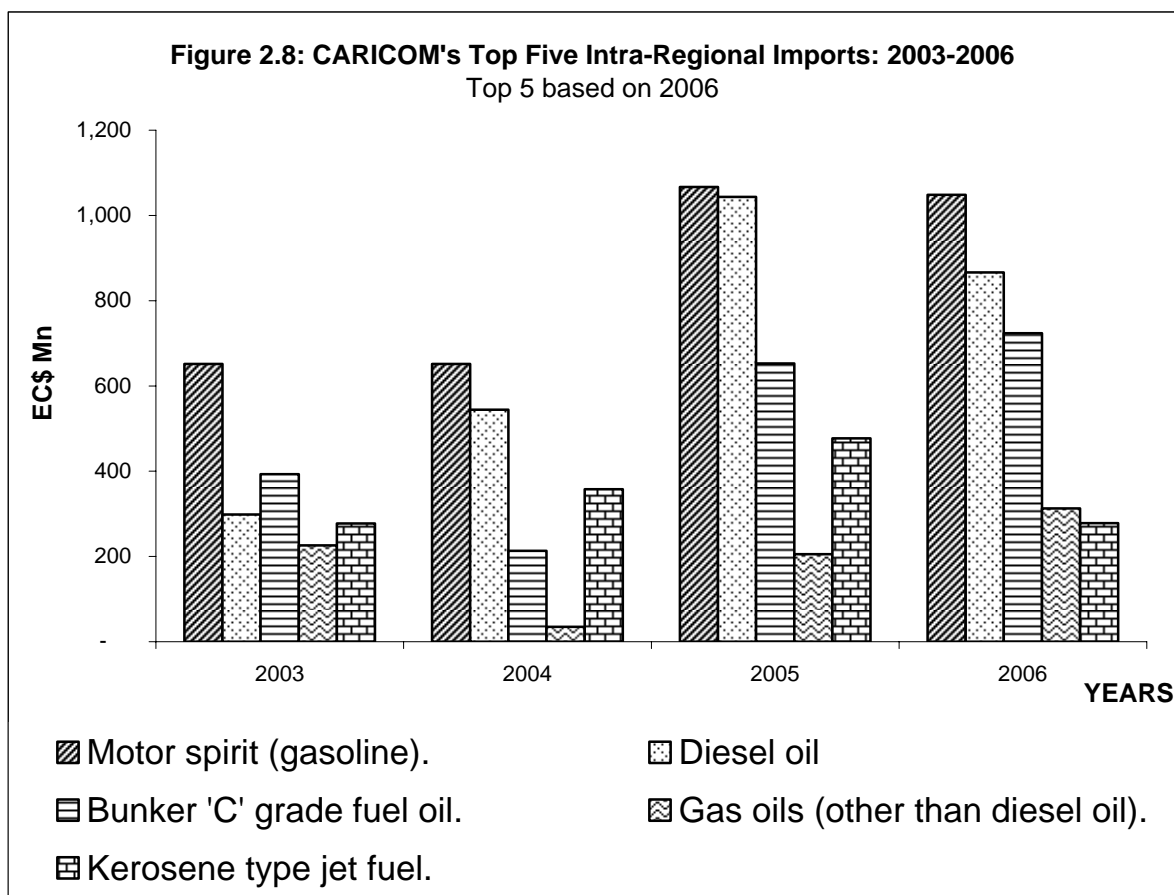


Table 2.13 shows that for the period 2003-2006, *Trinidad and Tobago* was the major source of CARICOM's top ten intra-regional imports. For imports of *motor spirit (gasoline)*, *diesel oil* and *kerosene type jet fuel*, this Member State accounted for approximately all of CARICOM's intra-regional imports of these commodities over the period. For imports of *bunker 'C' grade fuel oil*, *Trinidad and Tobago* was the top intra-regional supplier with percentage contributions ranging from 84.5 percent and 97.7 percent. For imports of *gas oils (other than diesel)*, *Trinidad and Tobago* accounted for 91.6 percent in 2004, 95.8 percent in 2005 and all of the Region's intra-regional imports of this commodity in 2003 and 2006.

Domestic Exports

In 2006, CARICOM's top ten intra-regional domestic exports accounted for 70.2 percent of its total intra-regional domestic exports. Over the period, 2003-2006, these commodities on average represented 58.8 percent of total intra-regional domestic exports. Of the top ten intra-regional domestic exports, the first five commodities in 2006 were:

- Gas oils (other than diesel oil) (EC\$1,712.4 Mn);
- Motor spirit (gasoline) (EC\$1,523.0 Mn)
- Kerosene type jet fuel (EC\$778.1 Mn)
- Other fuel oils n.e.s. (EC\$777.3 Mn) and
- Cane sugar, raw (EC\$110.4 Mn)

Collectively these top five commodities represented 64.8 percent of CARICOM's total intra-regional domestic exports (**Table 2.14**).

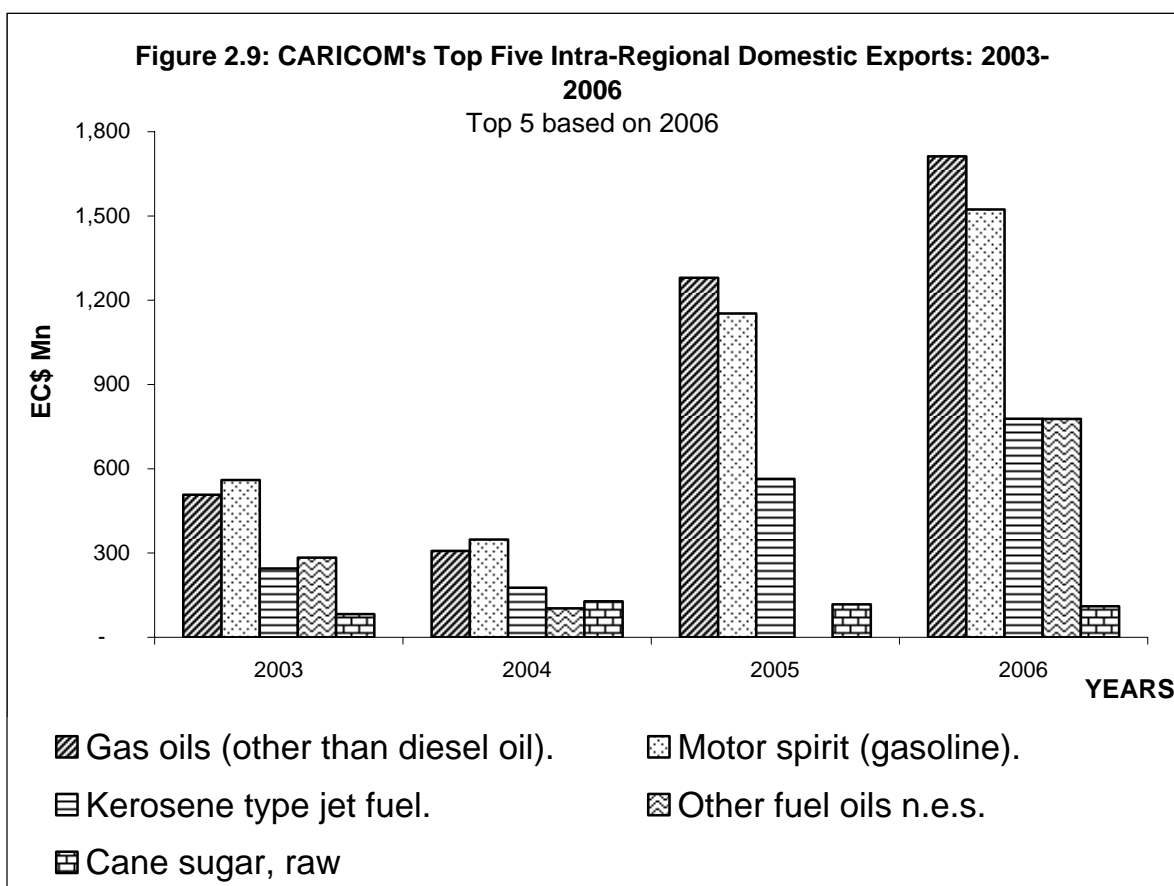


Table 2.15 shows that for 2003-2006, *Jamaica* and *Guyana* were the top destinations for CARICOM's intra-regional domestic exports of *gas oils (other than diesel oils)*. In 2003, *Jamaica* accounted for EC\$144.6 Mn (US\$53.6 Mn) or 28.5 percent of CARICOM's domestic exports of this commodity as compared to EC\$527.0 Mn (US\$195 Mn) or 30.8 percent in 2006. *Guyana*, the other top destination accounted for 23.2 percent in 2003 and 20.5 percent in 2006 of total intra-regional domestic exports of *gas oils (other than diesel oils)*.

For intra-regional domestic exports of *motor spirit (gasoline)*, *Jamaica* was the top destination with percentage contributions ranging from 44.5 percent and 51.1 percent while for intra-regional domestic exports of *kerosene type jet fuel*, *Barbados* was the top destination with percentage contributions declining from 58.3 percent in 2003 to 48.3 percent in 2006. *Jamaica* was the top destination for intra-regional domestic exports of *other fuel oils n.e.s.* accounting for 78.2 percent in 2003 and 47.9 percent in 2006. For intra-regional domestic of *raw cane sugar*, *Jamaica* and *Trinidad and Tobago* were the two top destinations. The percentage contributions of *Jamaica* decreased from 40.5 percent in 2003 and 27.1 percent in 2006 while for *Trinidad and Tobago*, the percentage contributions moved 39.1 percent in 2003 to 25.2 percent in 2006.

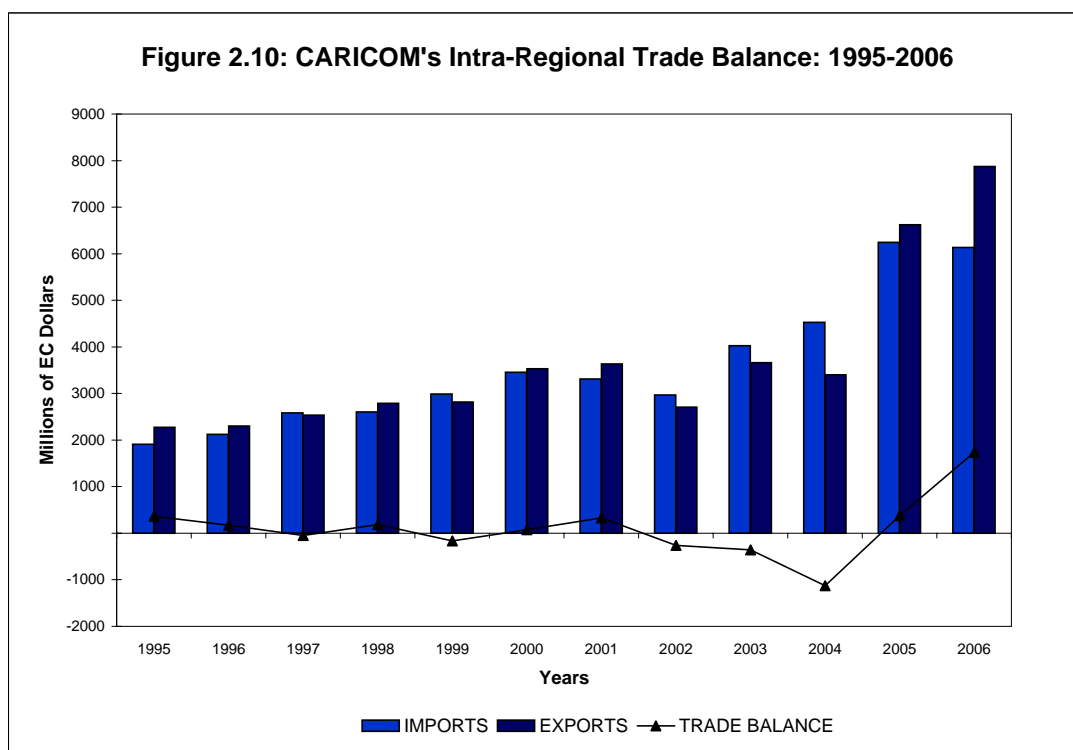

Figure 2.11: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Intra-regional Imports: 2001

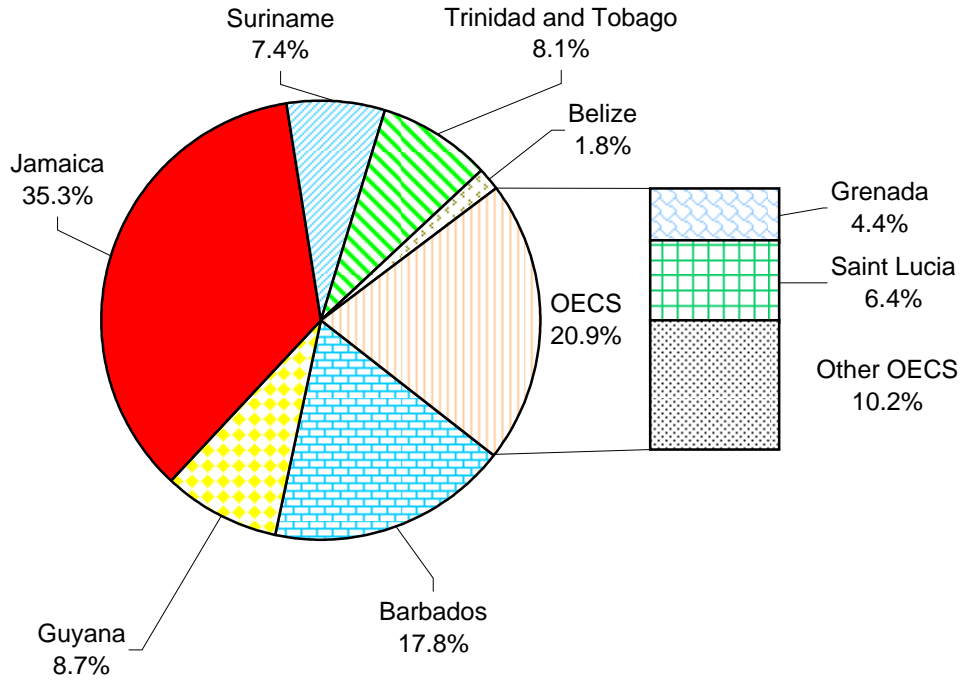


Figure 2.12: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Intra-regional Imports: 2006

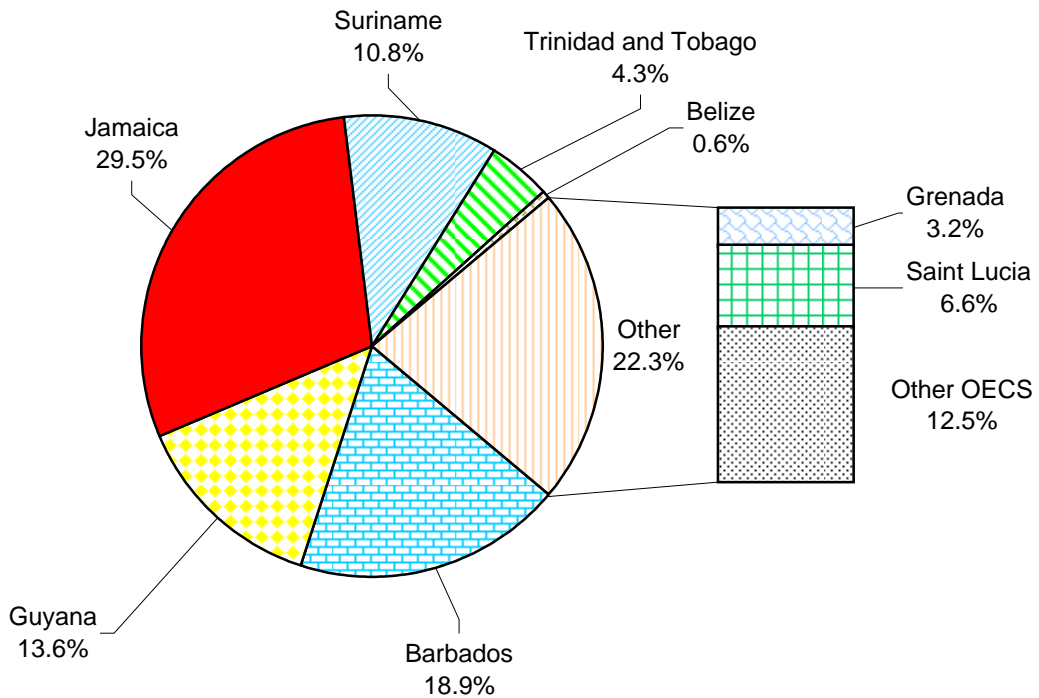

Figure 2.13: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Intra-regional Total Exports: 2001

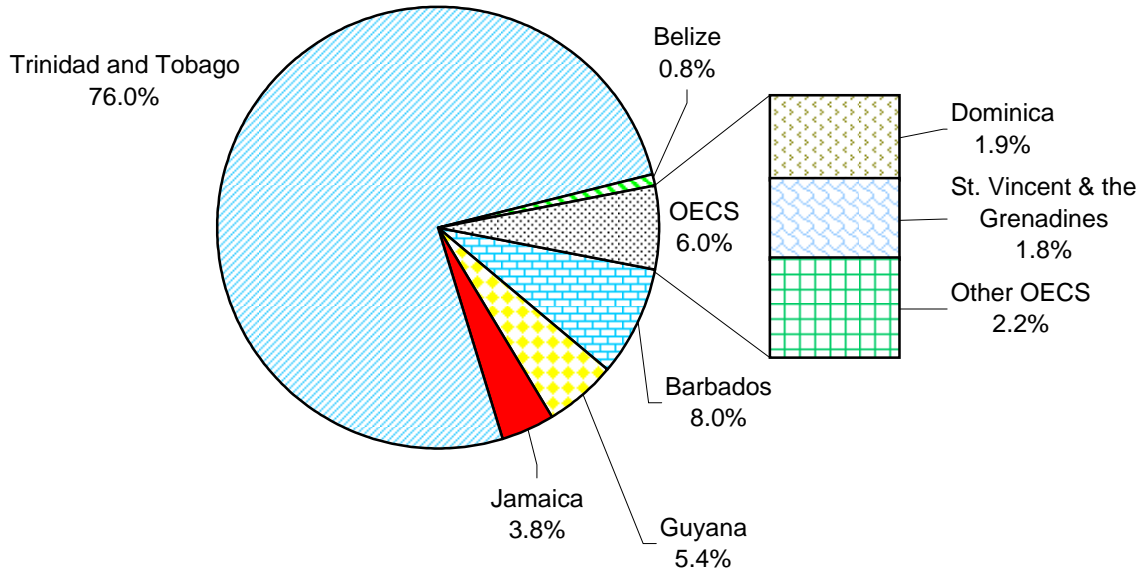


Figure 2.14: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Intra-regional Total Exports: 2006

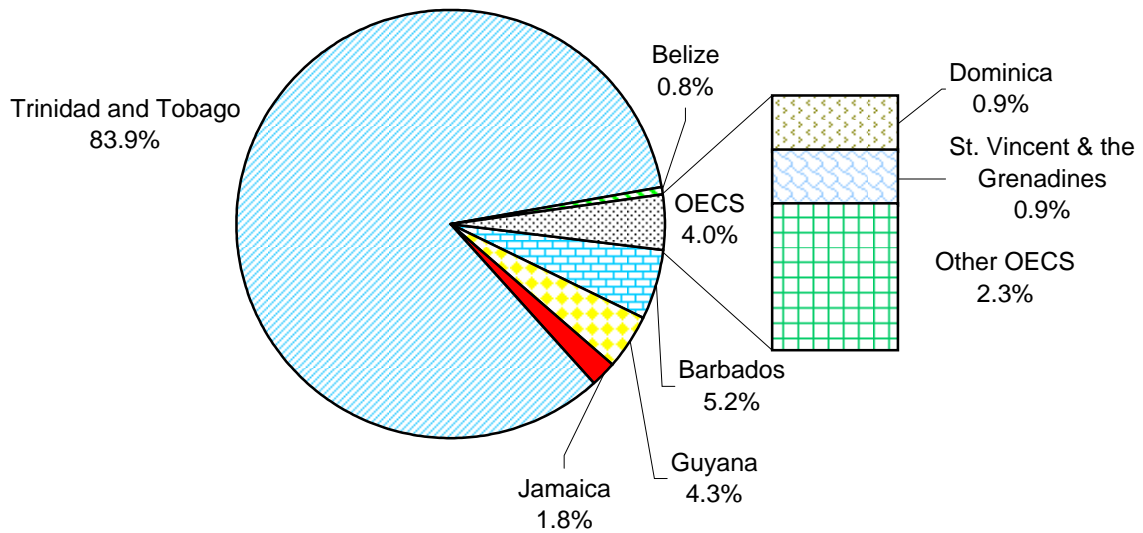

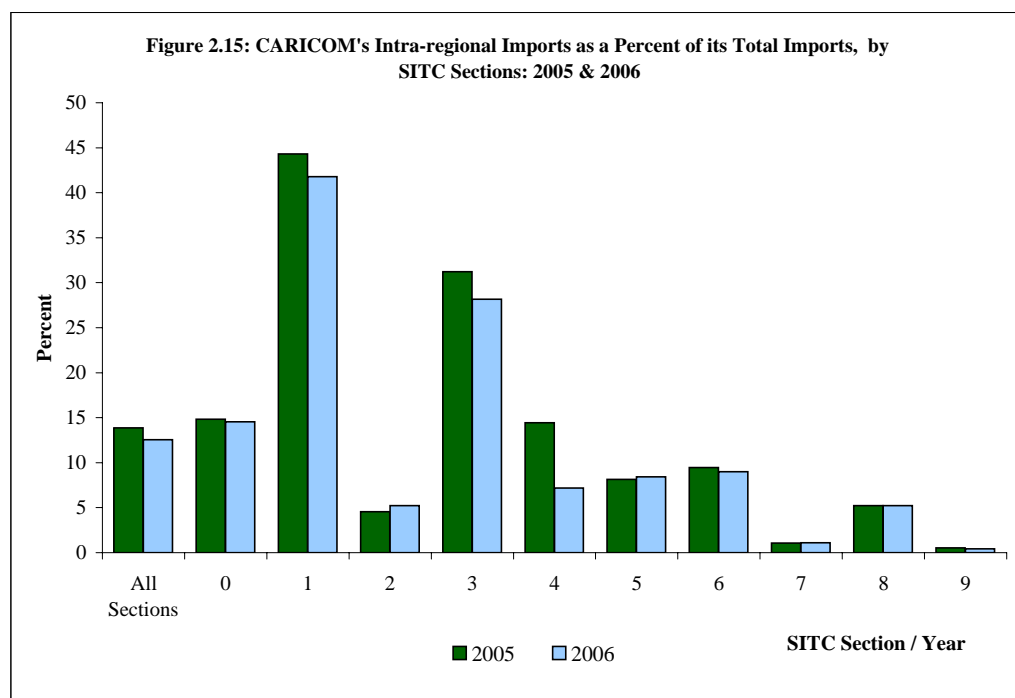

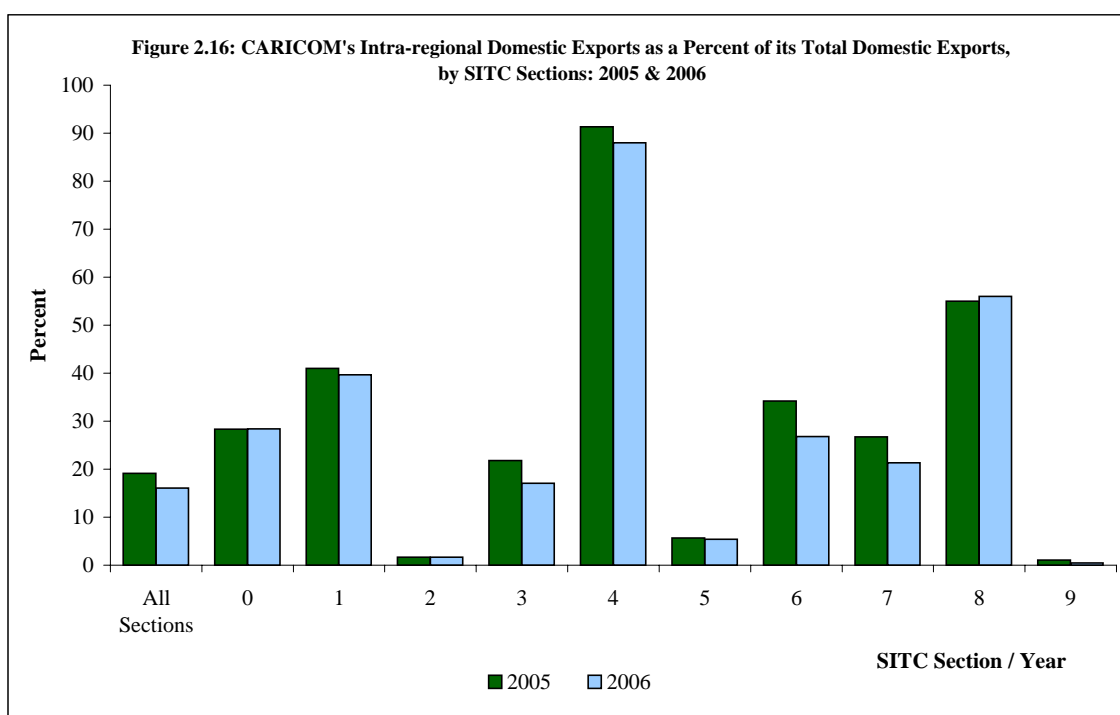

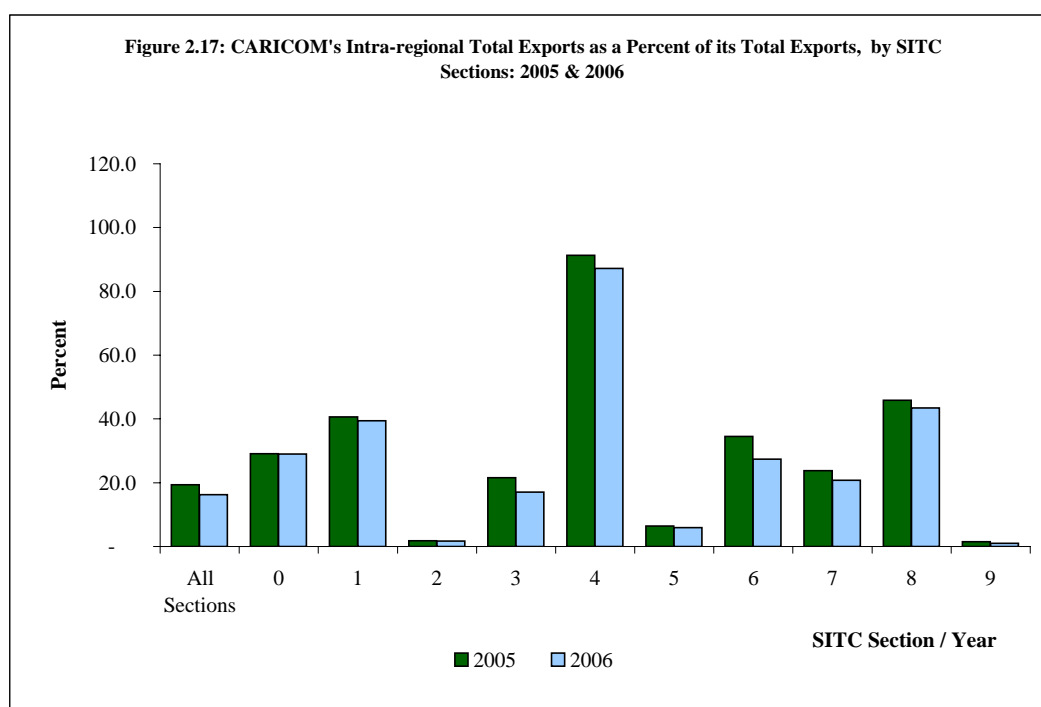
