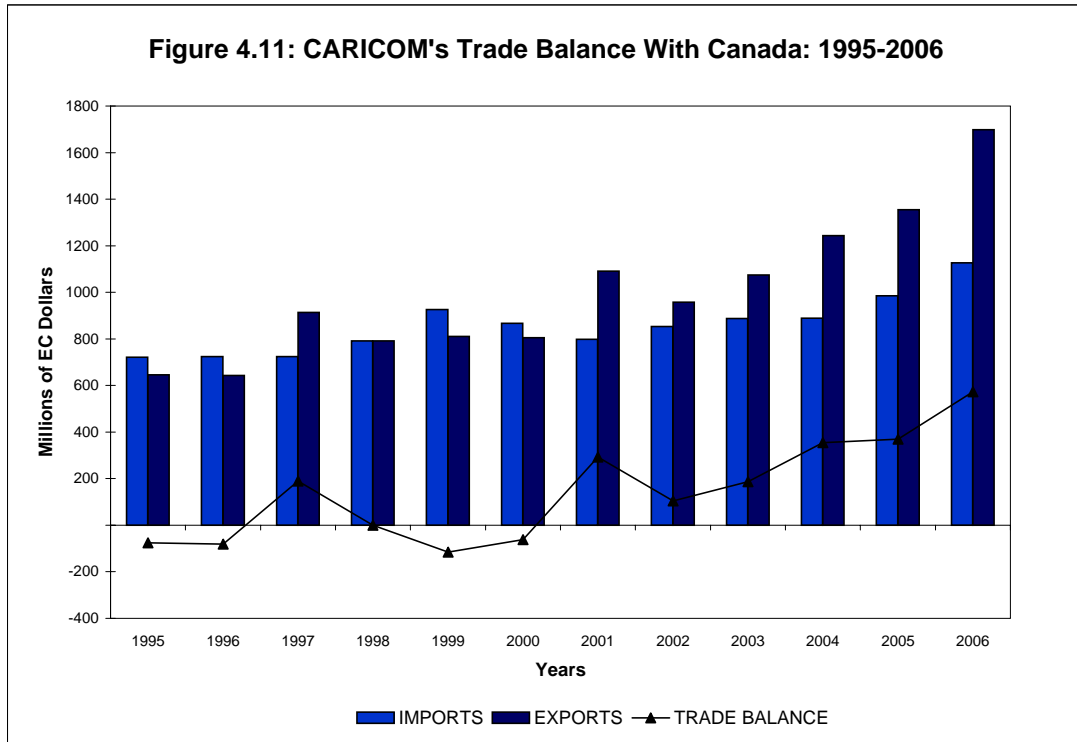

Figure 4.12: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Imports from Canada: 2001

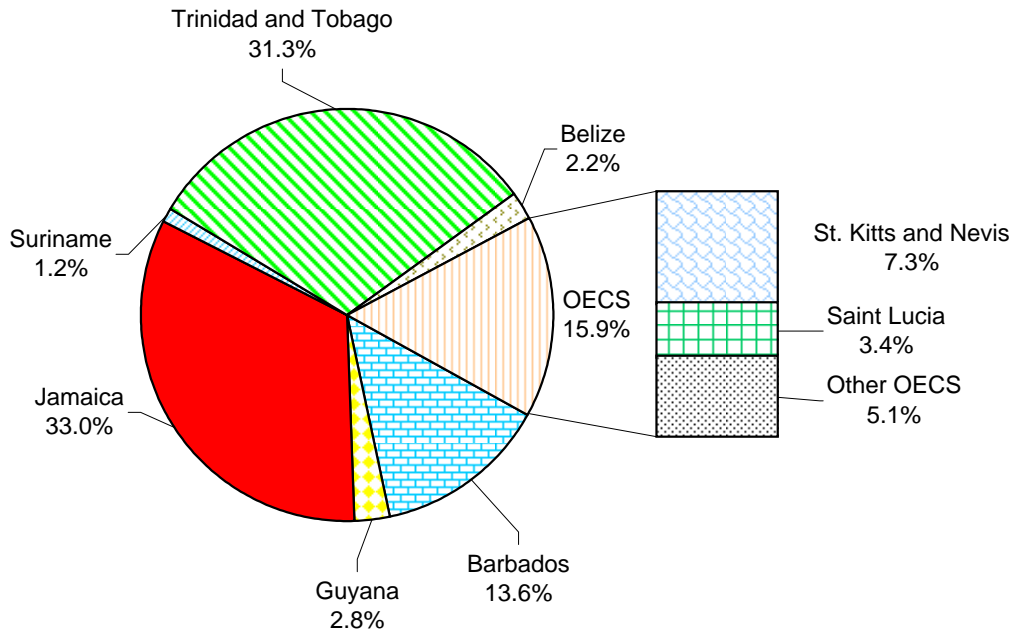


Figure 4.13: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Imports from Canada: 2006

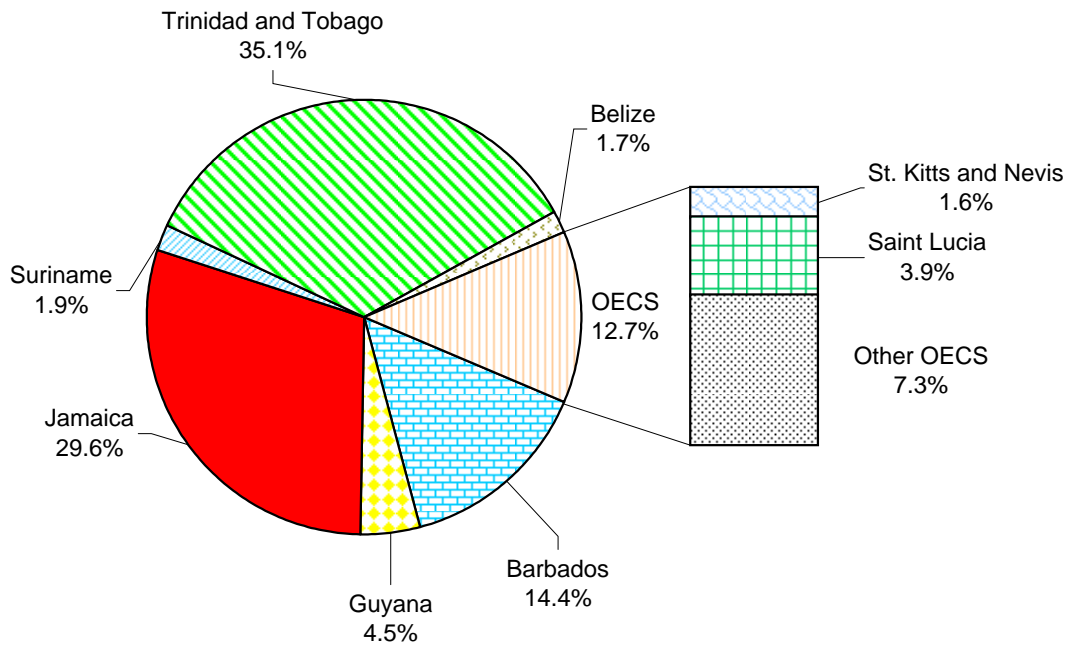


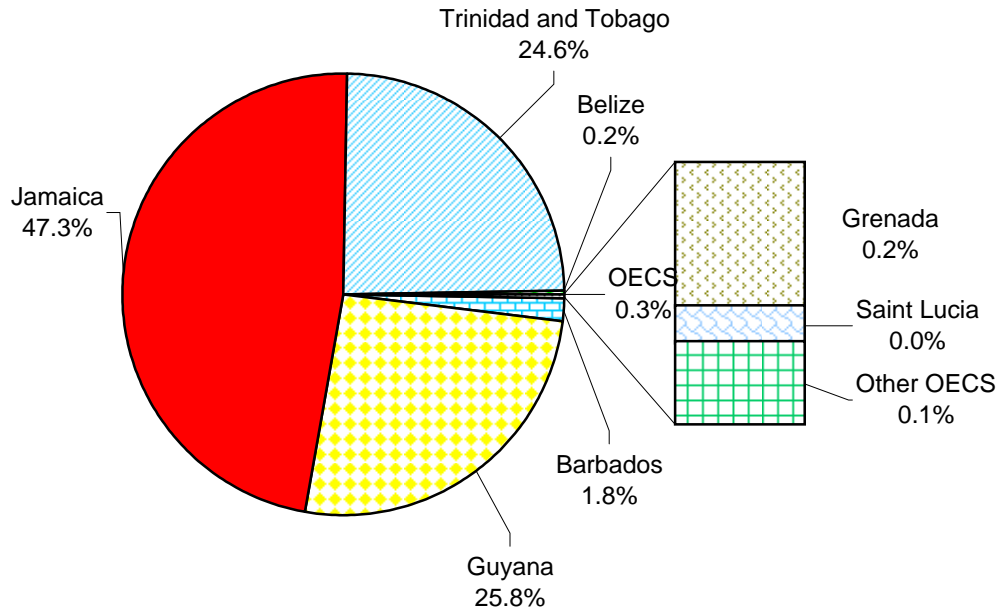

2006**

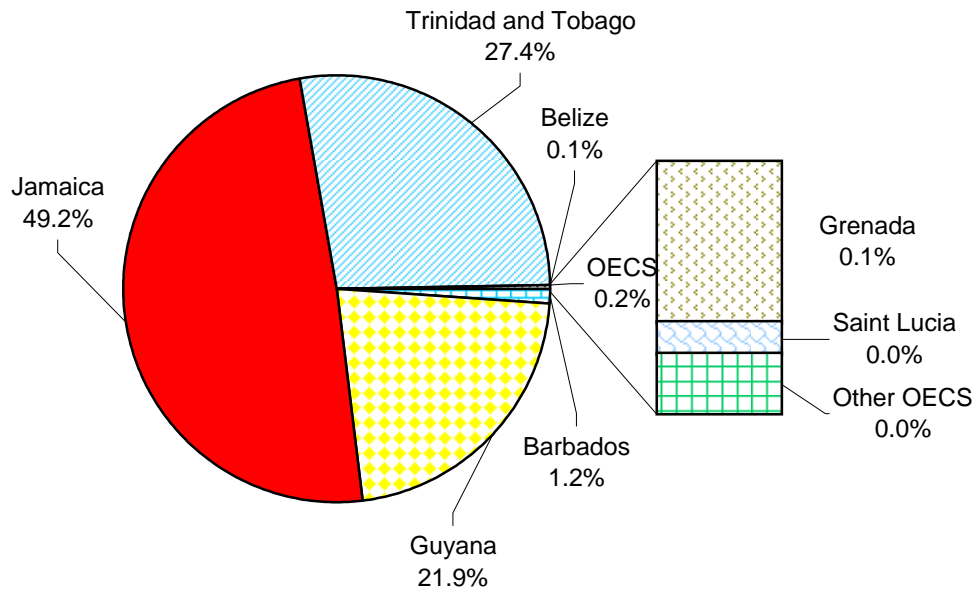

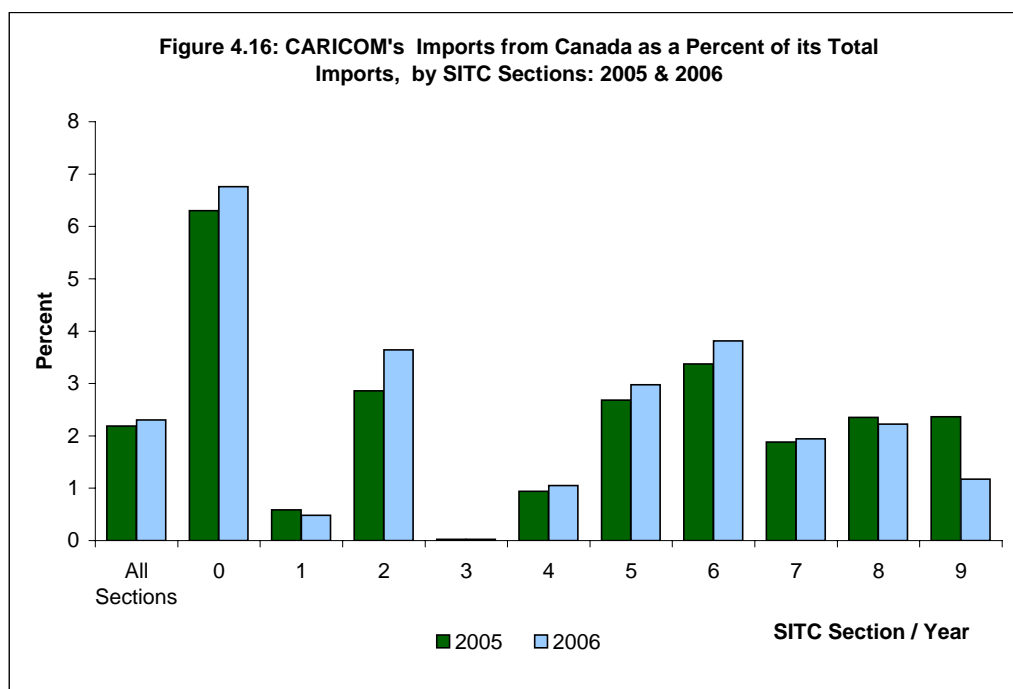

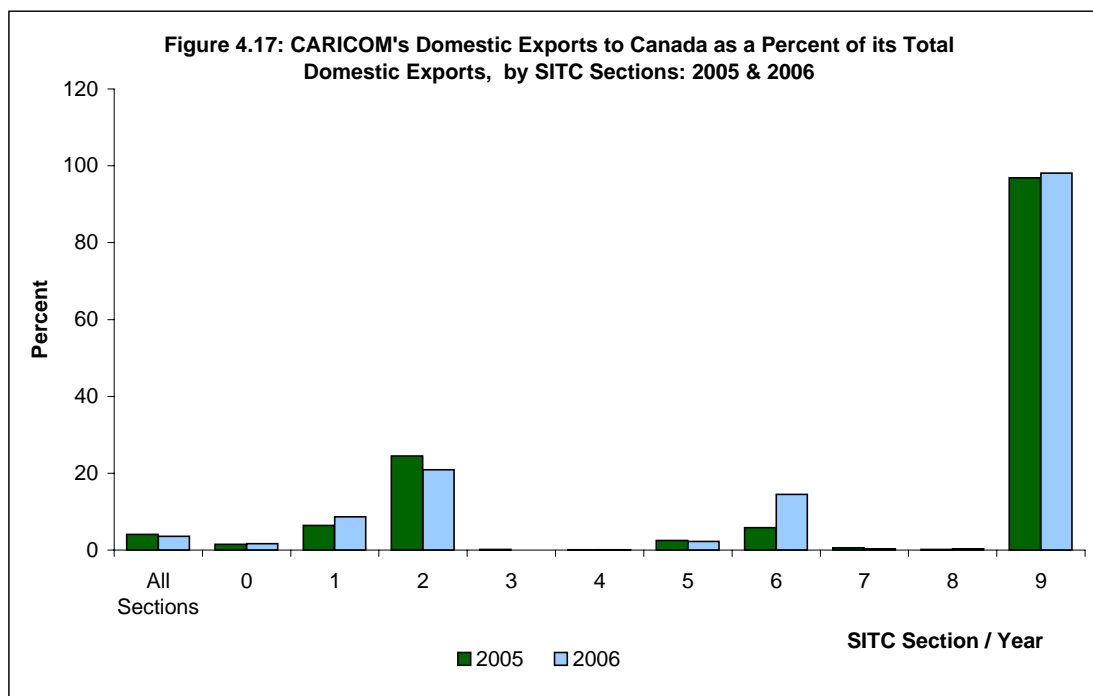
