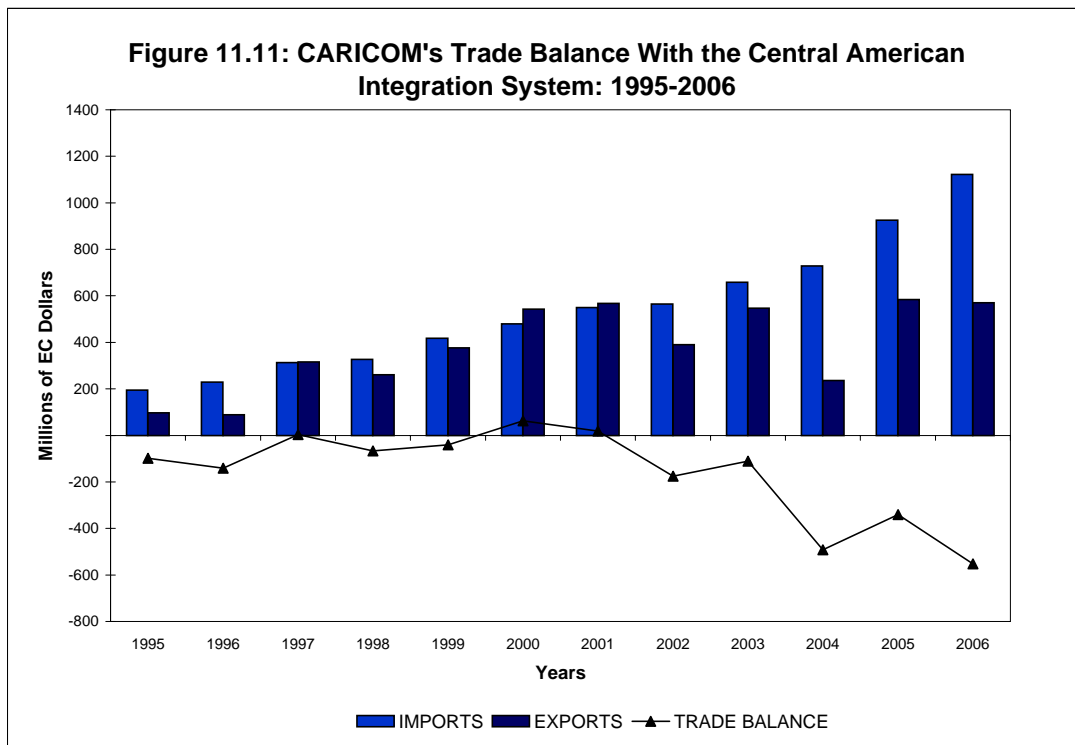

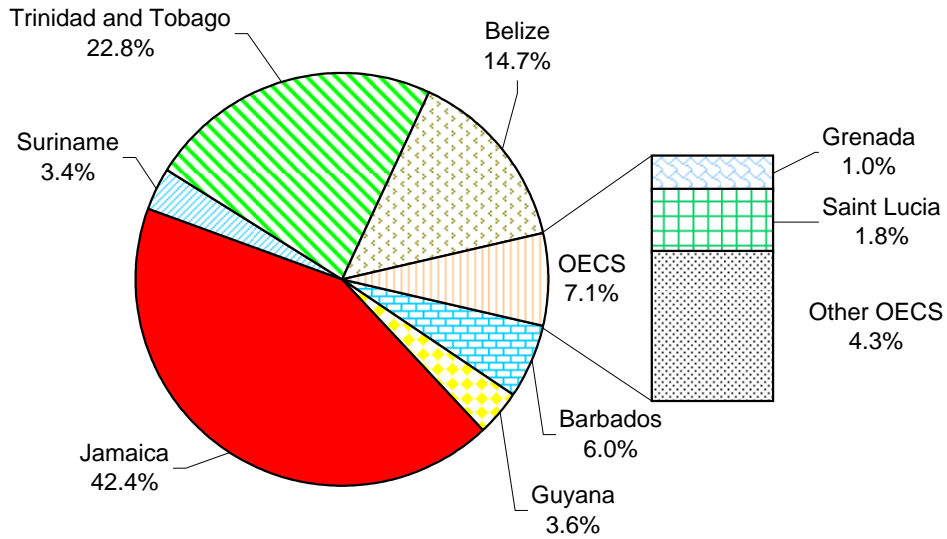

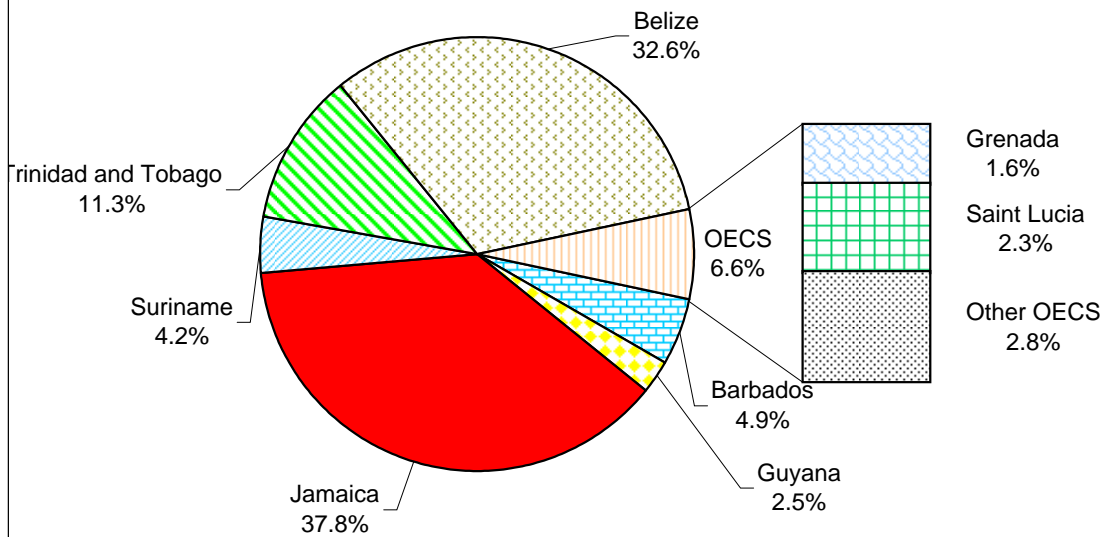

**Figure 11.13: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Imports from the Central American Integration System: 2006**



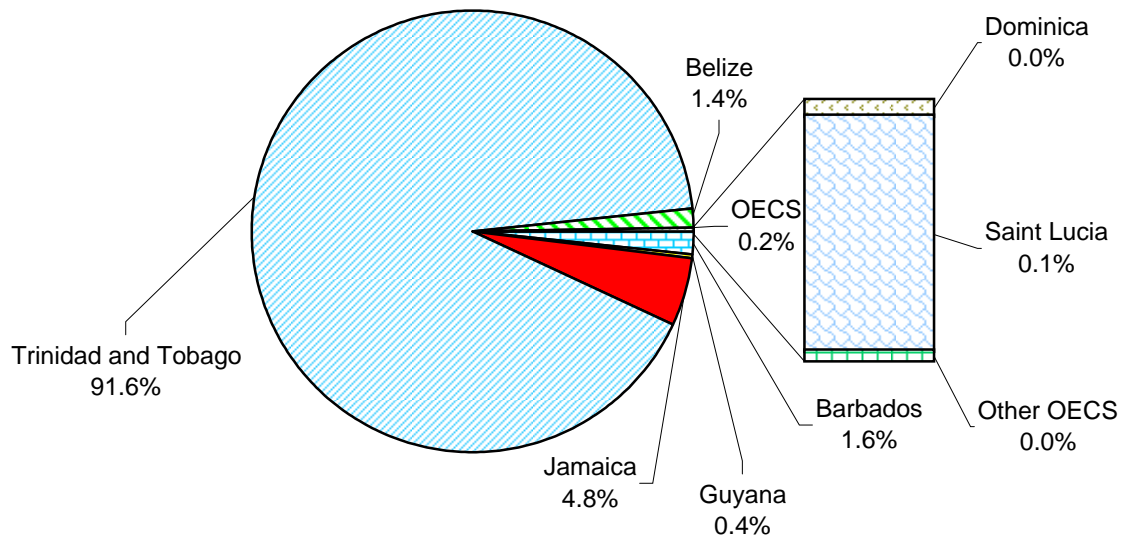

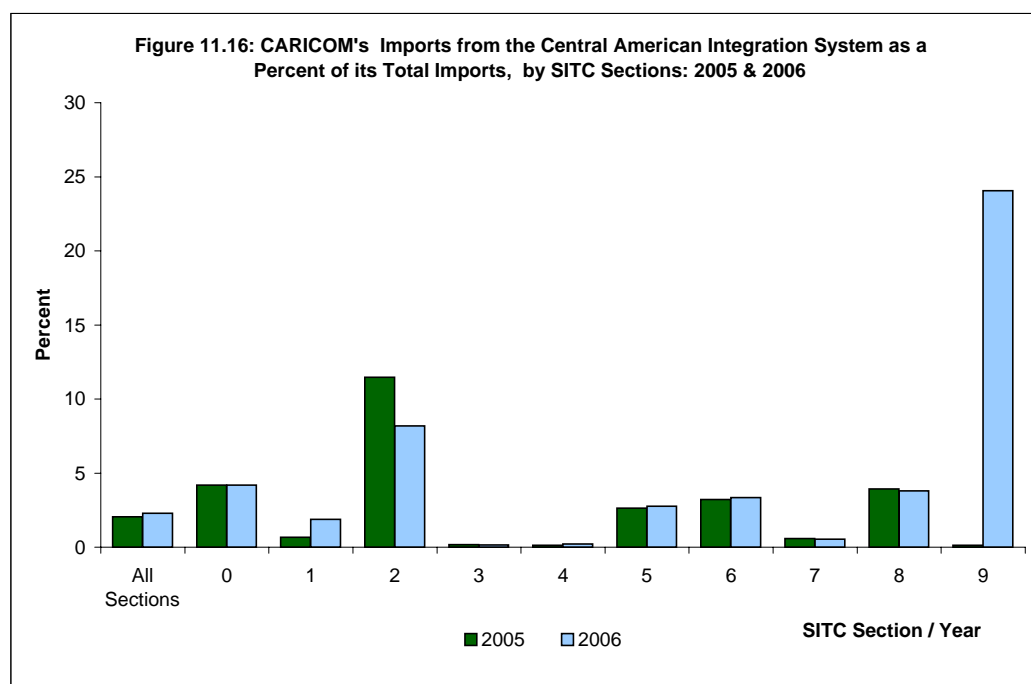
