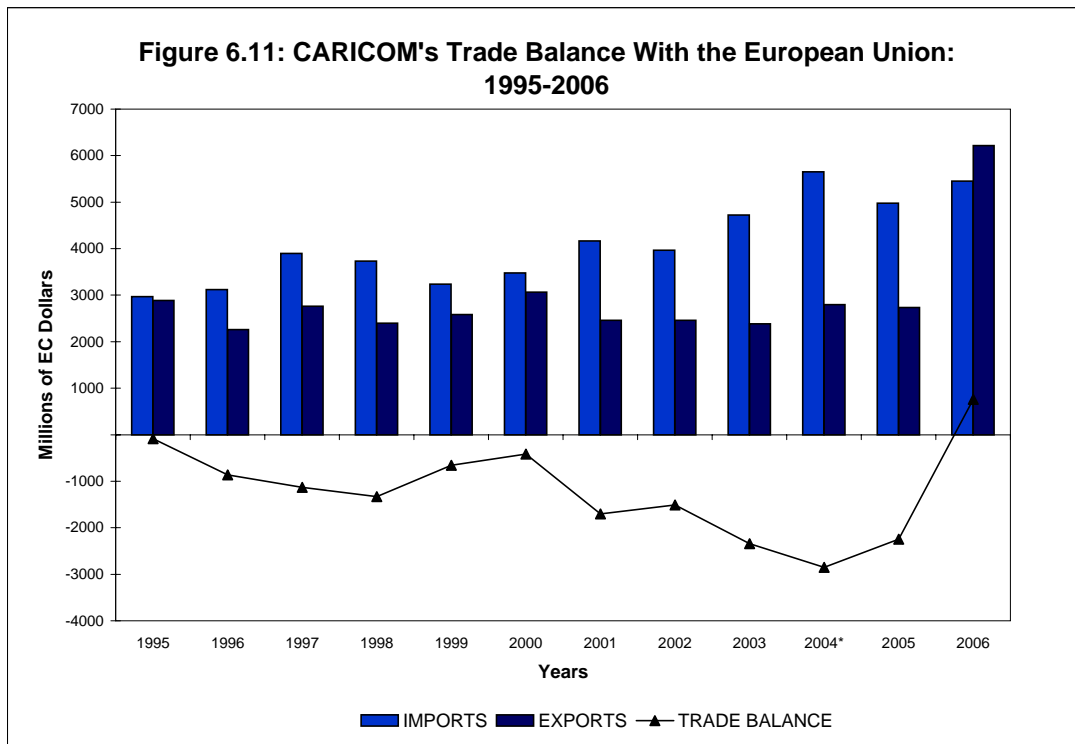

Figure 6.12: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Imports from the EU: 2001

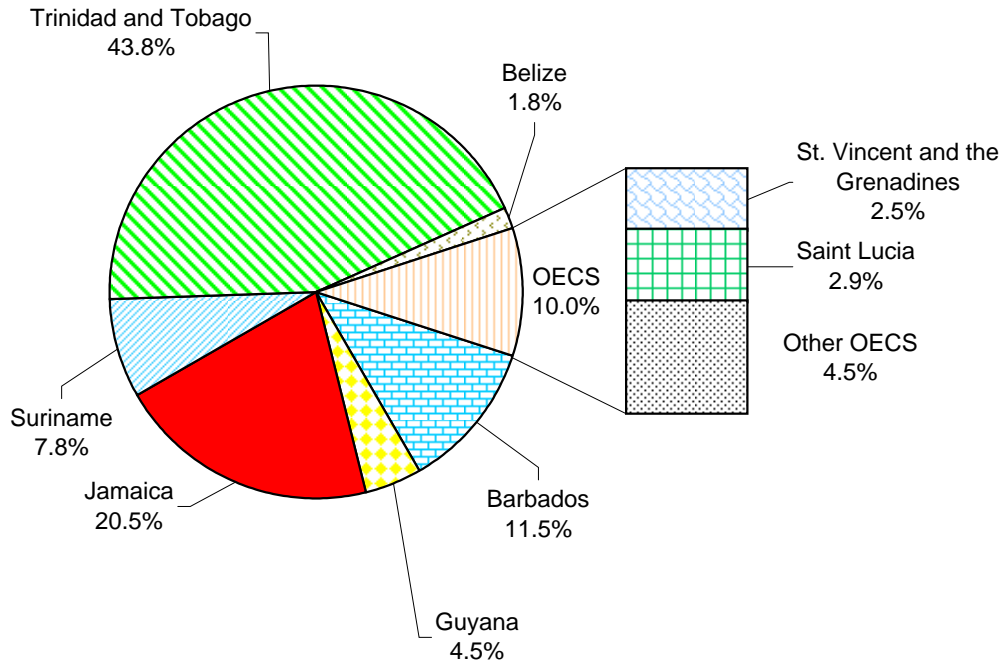


Figure 6.13: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Imports from the EU: 2006

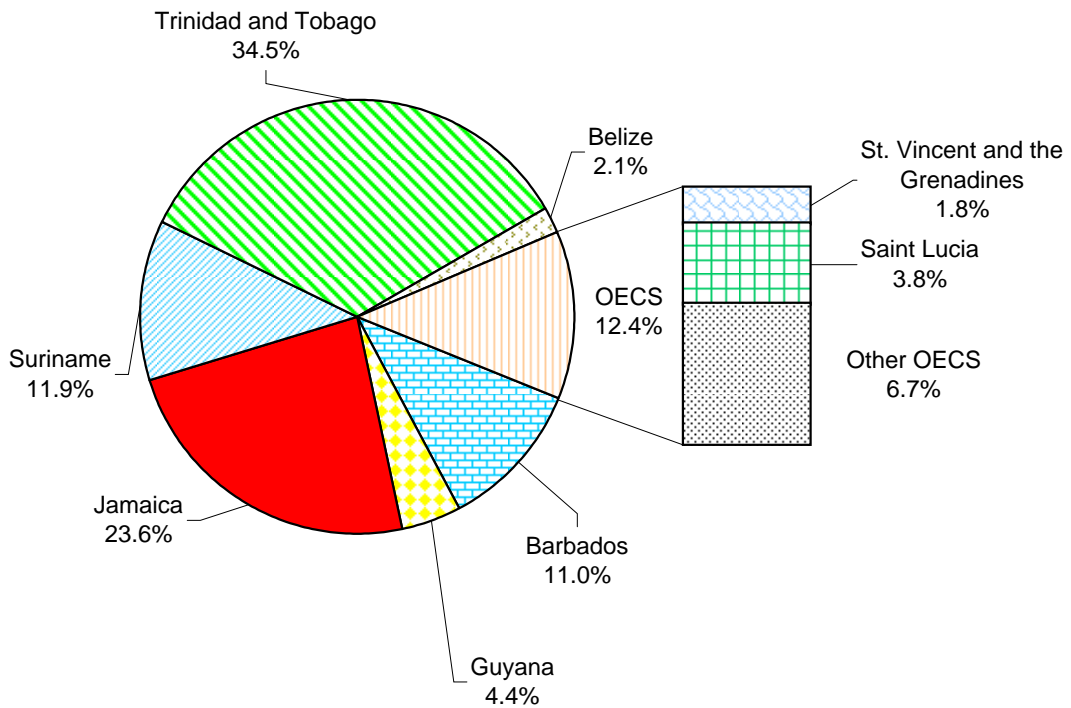


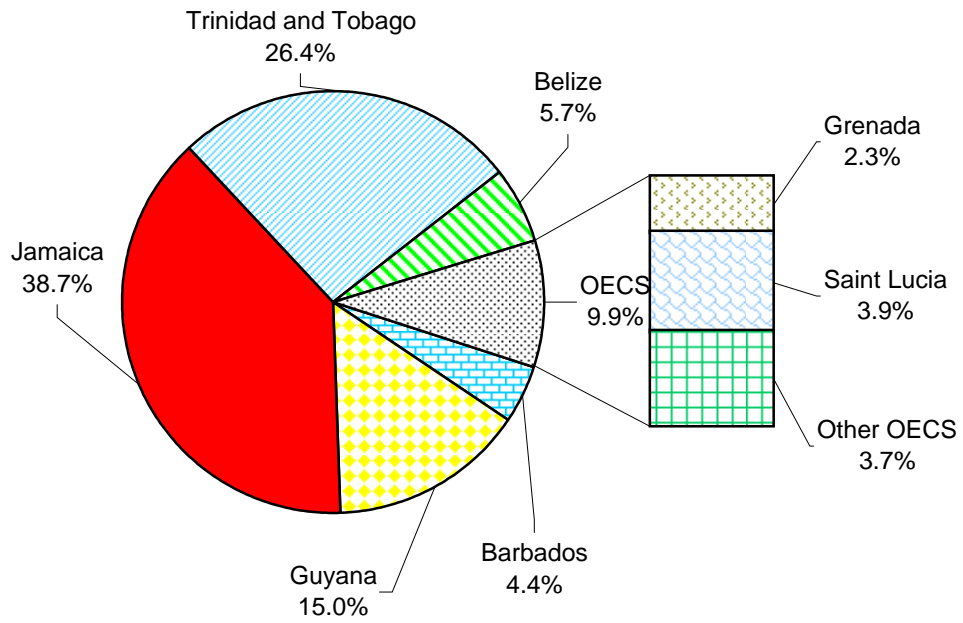

2006**

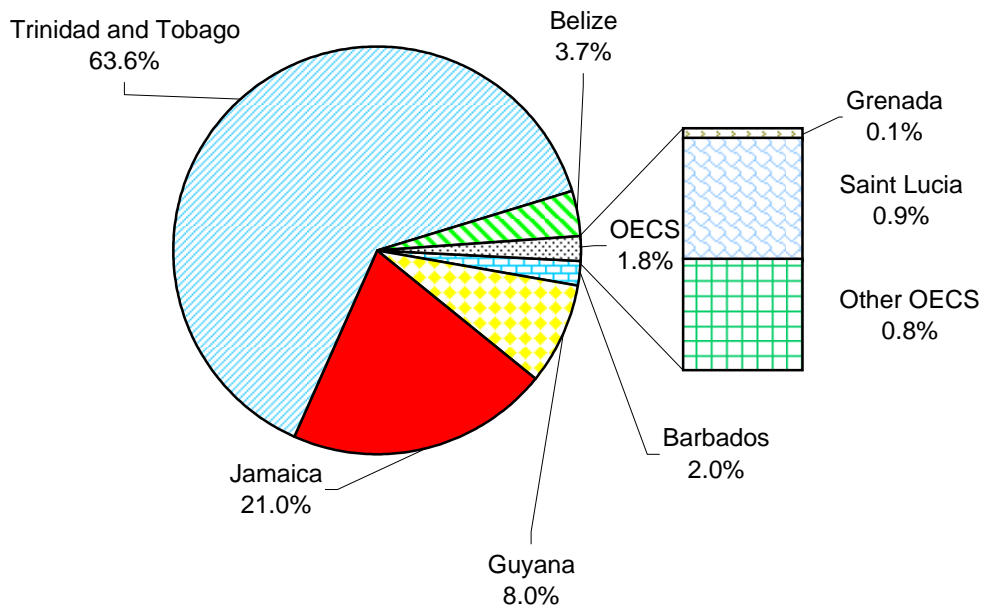

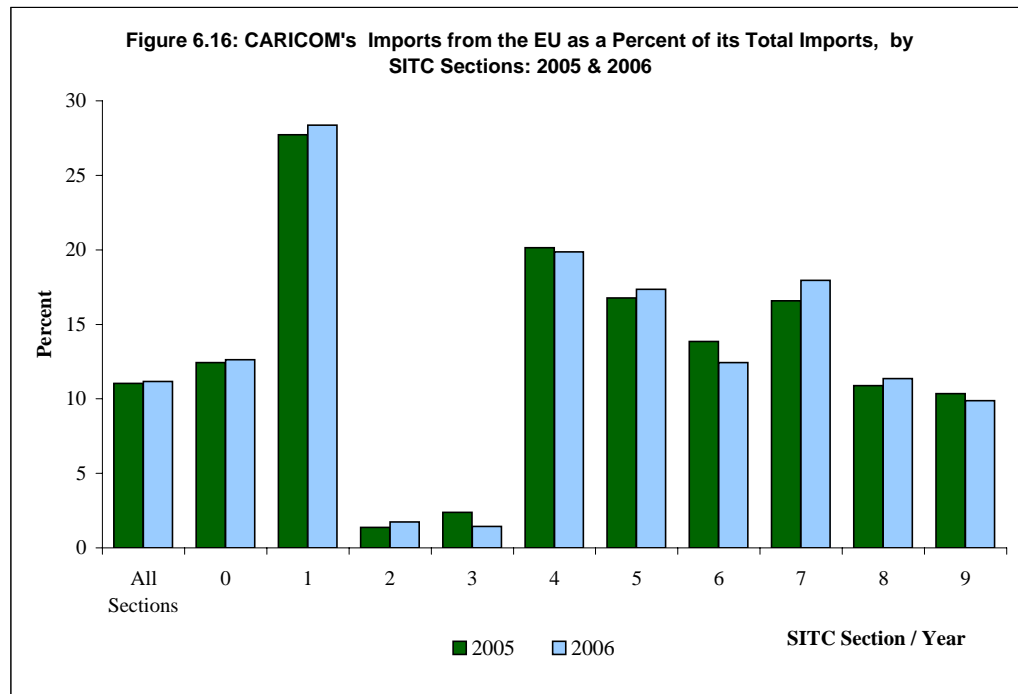

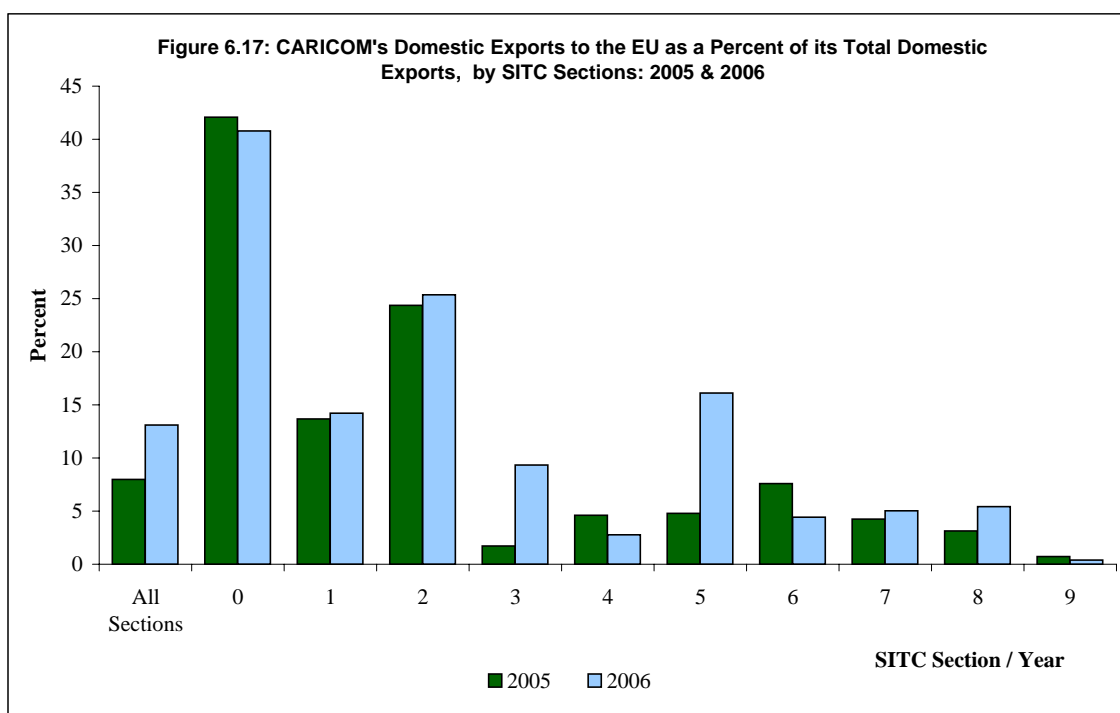
