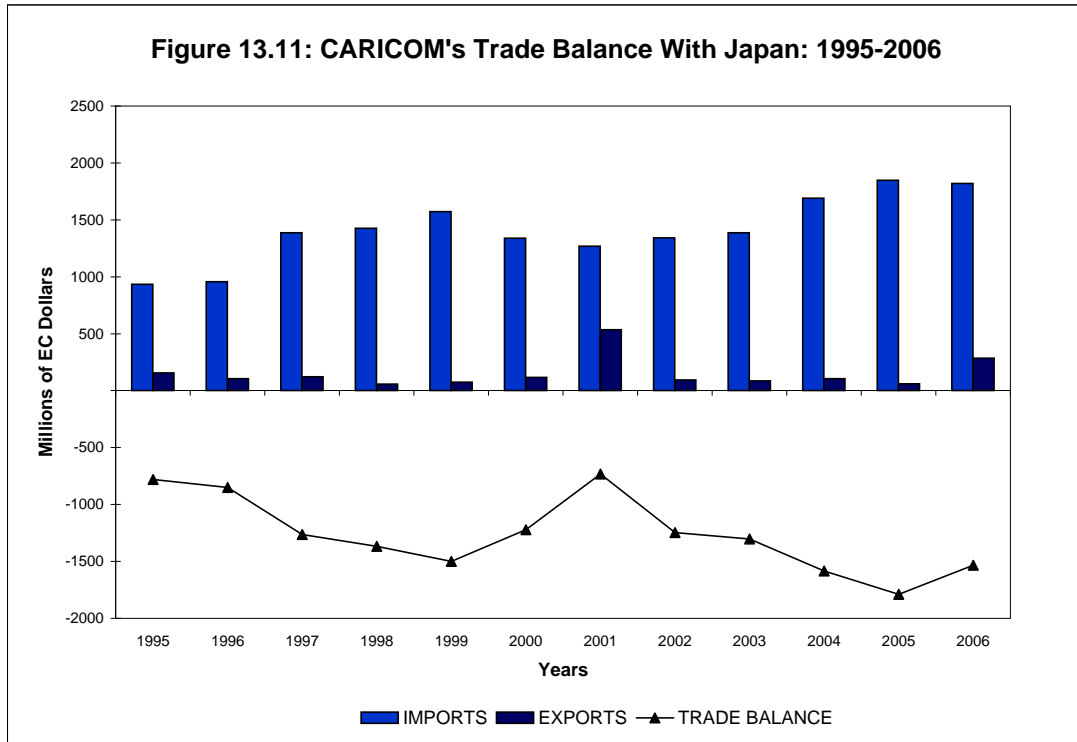

Figure 13.12: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Imports from the Japan: 2001

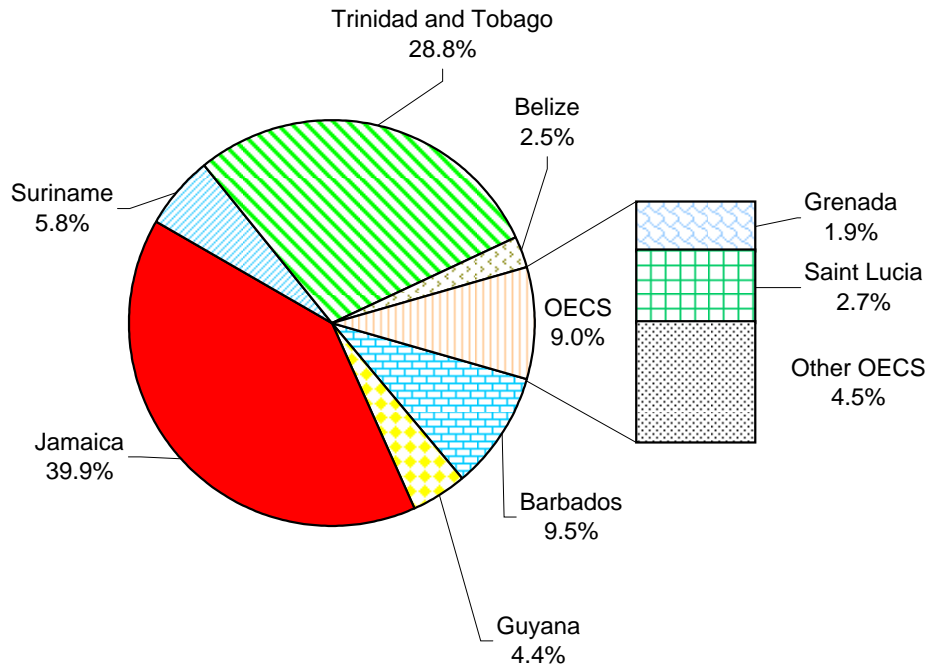


Figure 13.13: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Imports from the Japan: 2006

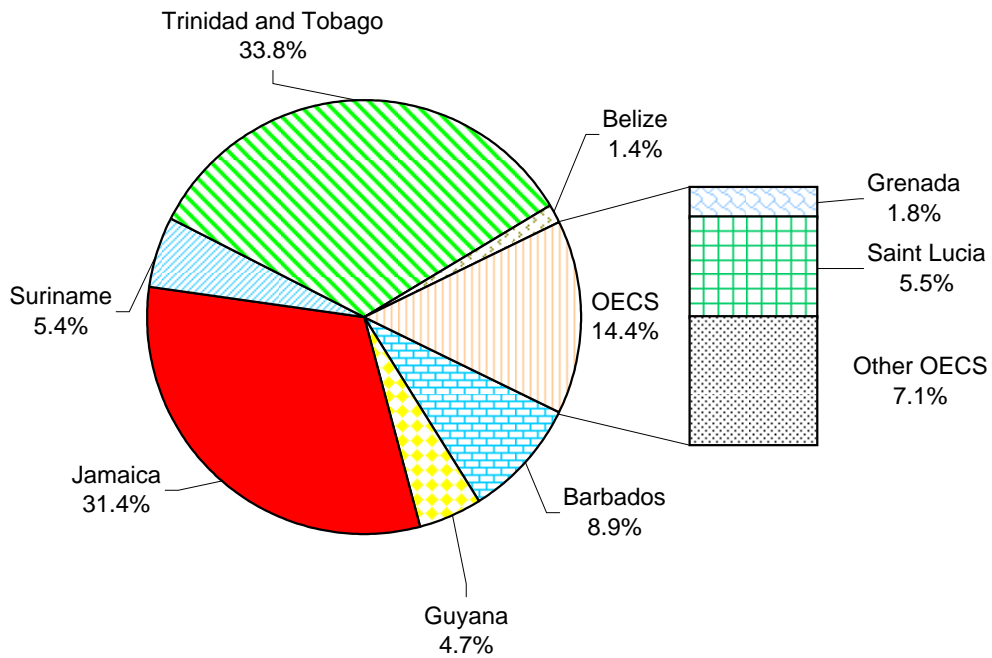


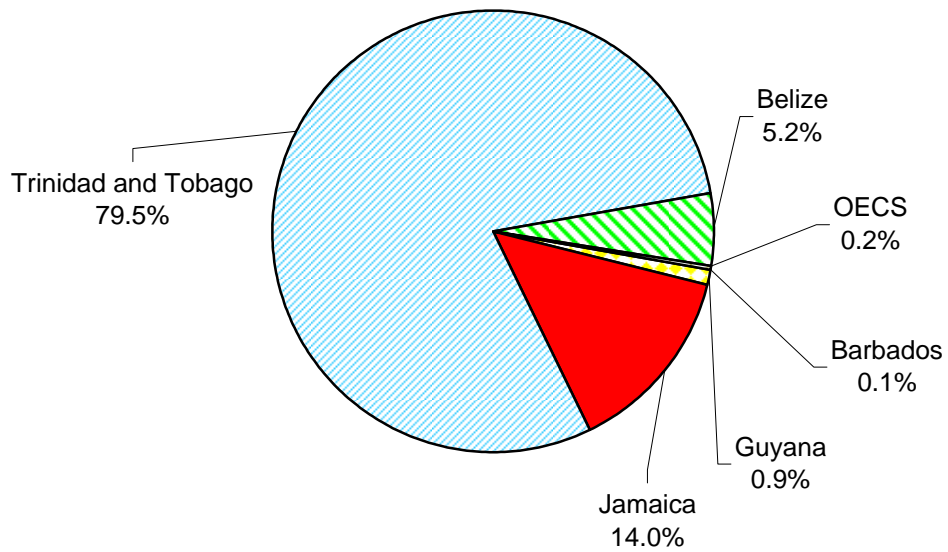

2006**

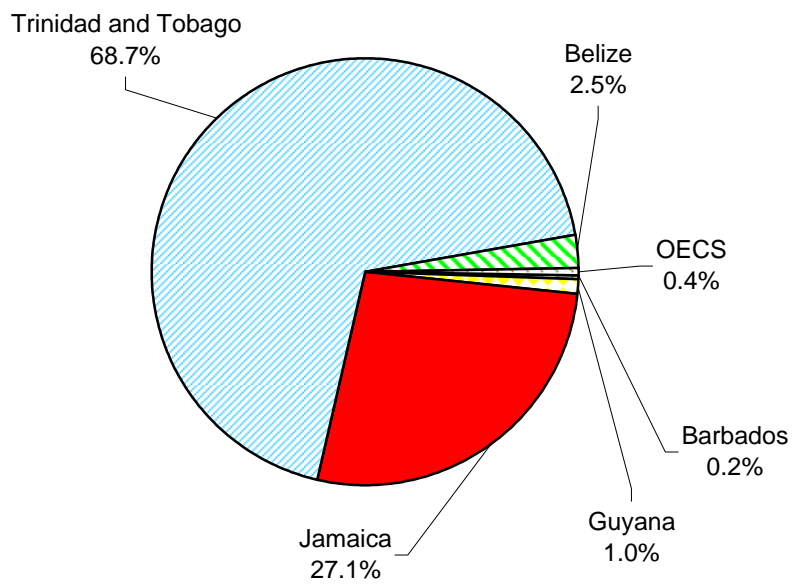

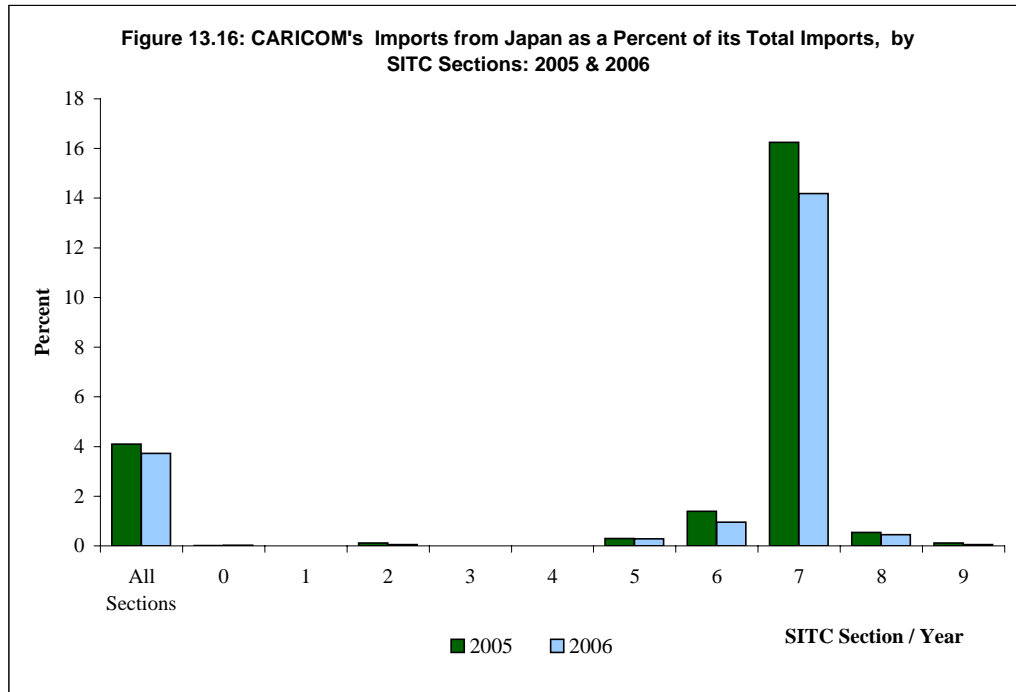

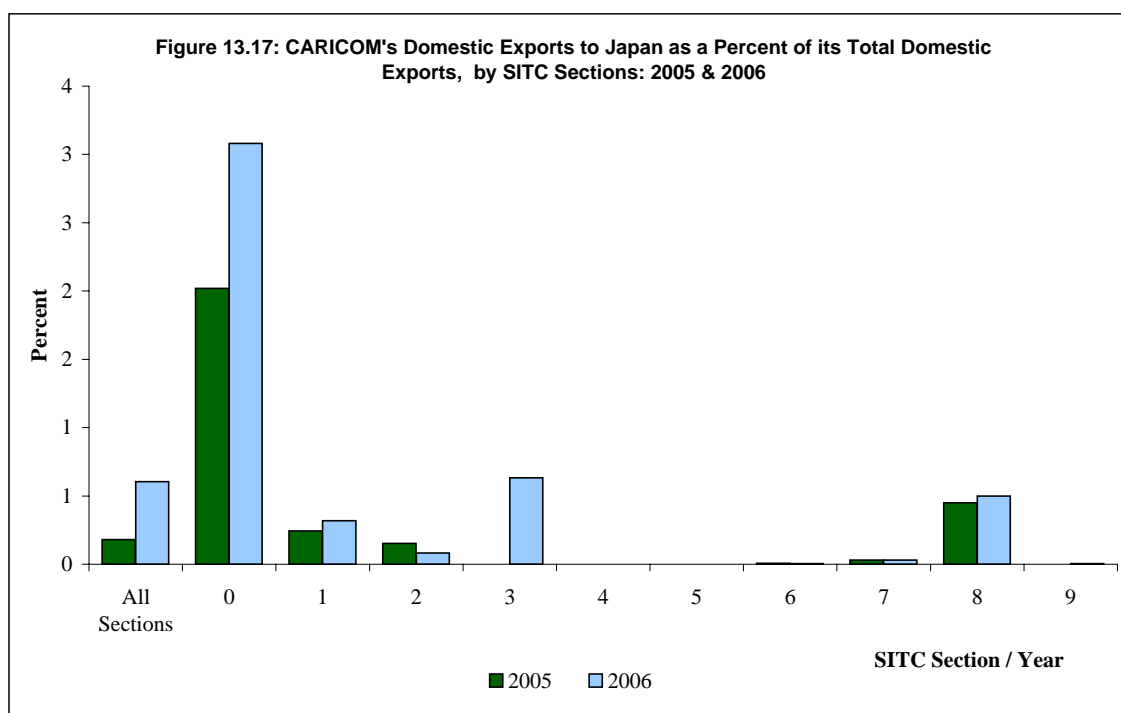
