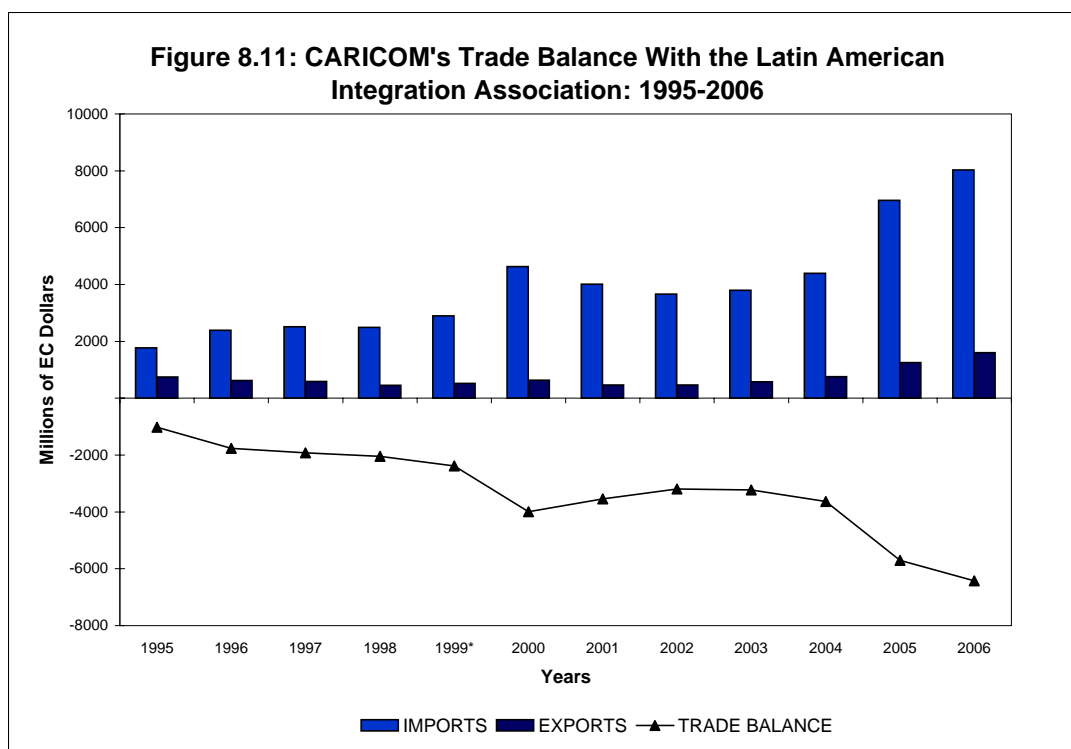

Figure 8.12: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Imports from LAIA: 2001

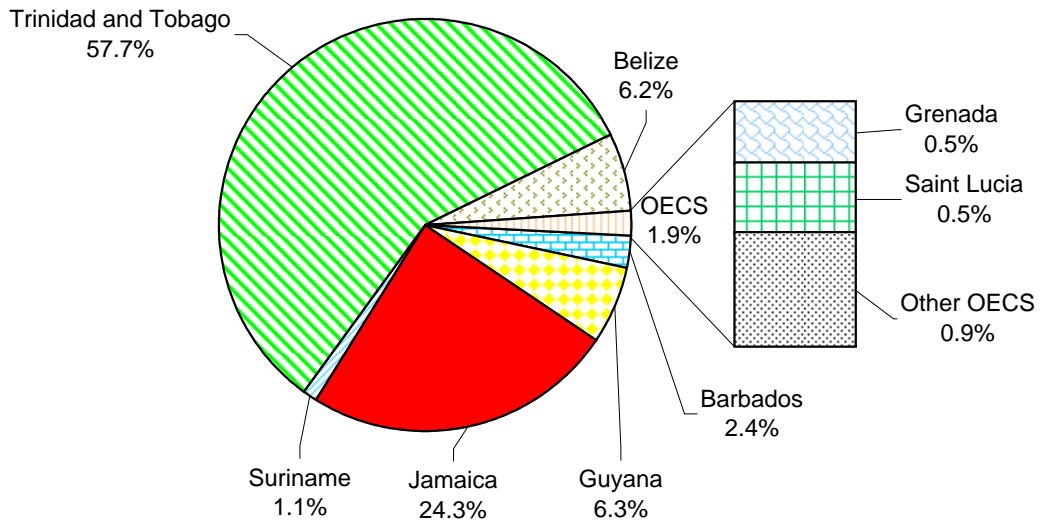


Figure 8.13: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Imports from LAIA: 2006

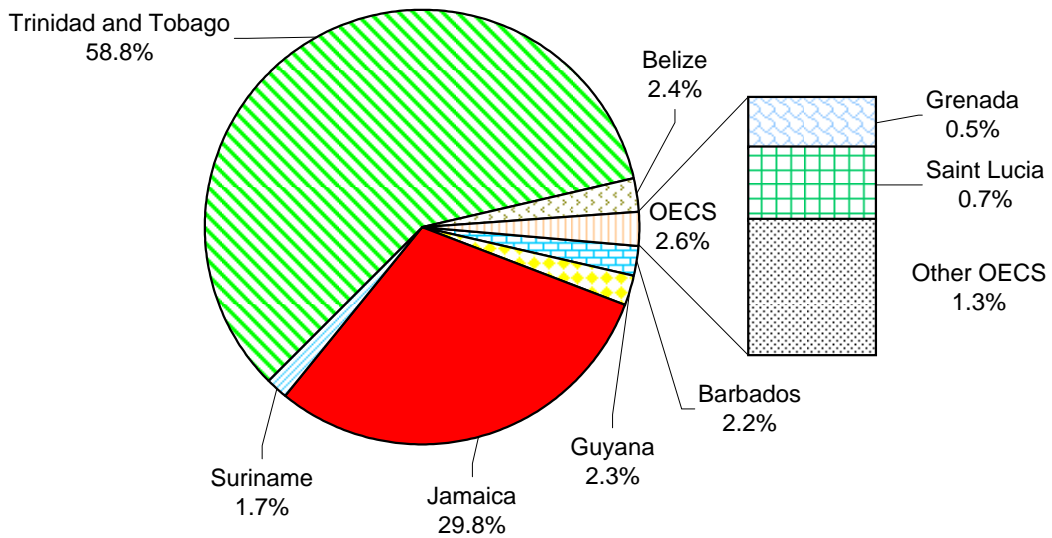

Figure 8.14: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Total Exports to LAIA: 2001

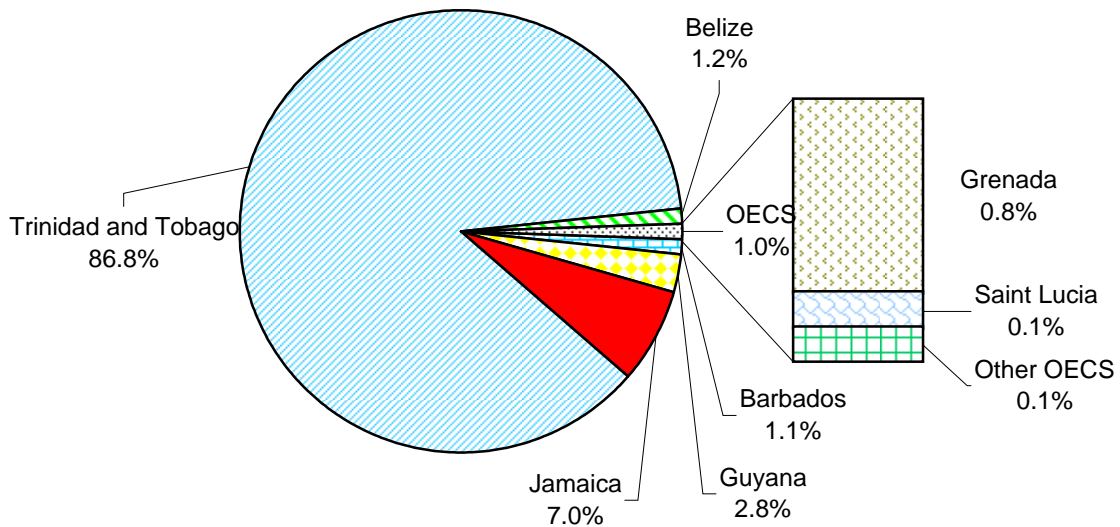


Figure 8.15: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Total Exports to LAIA: 2006

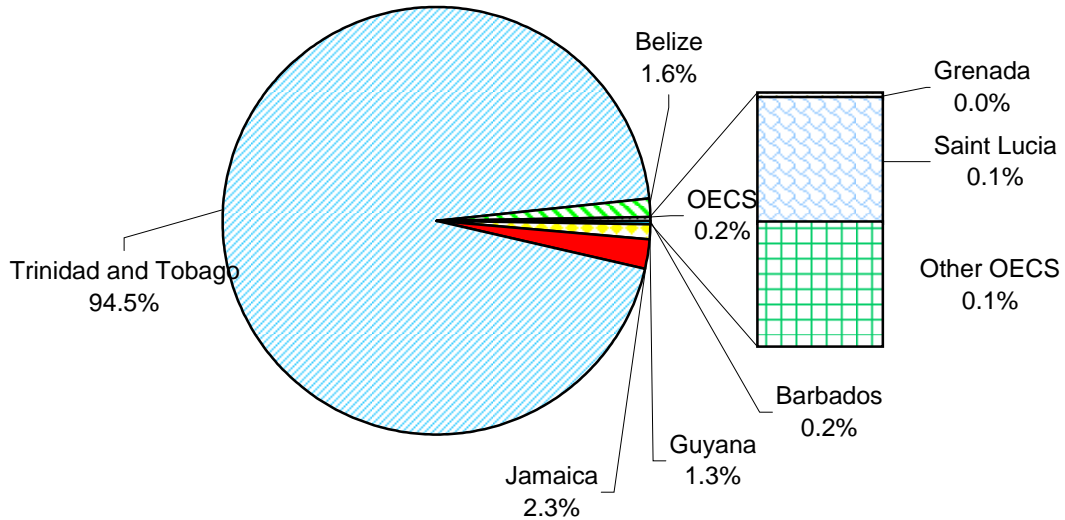

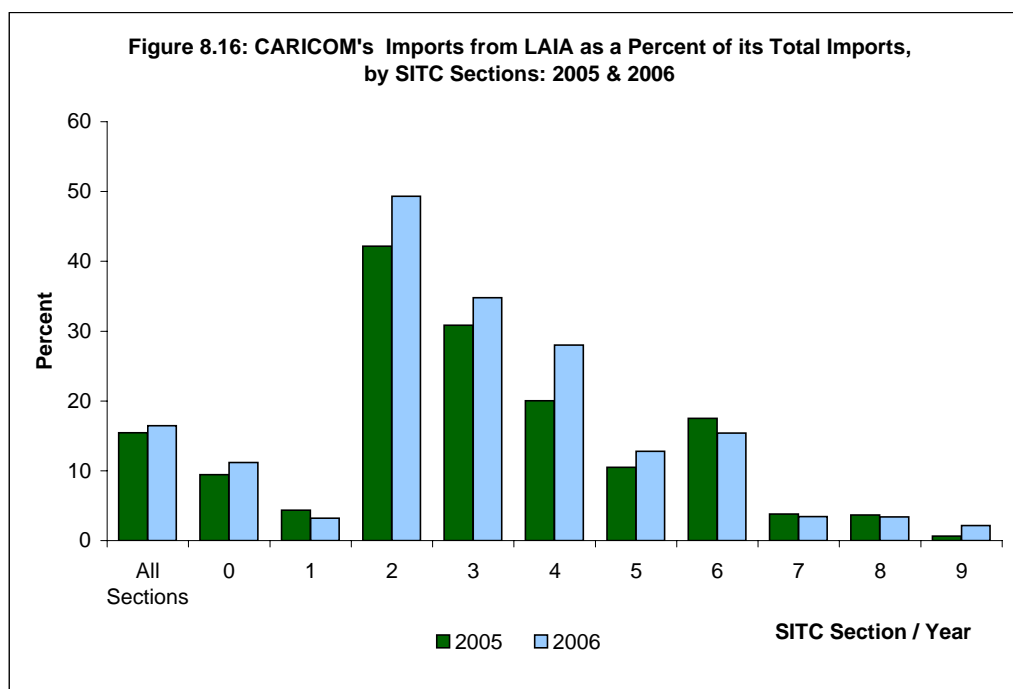

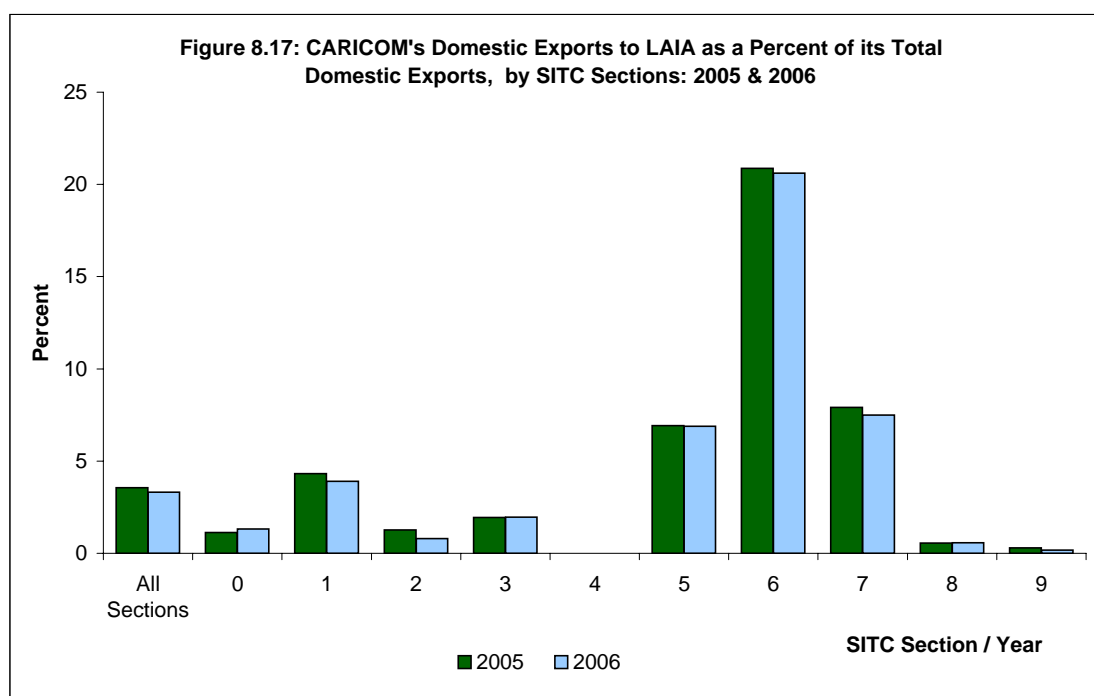
