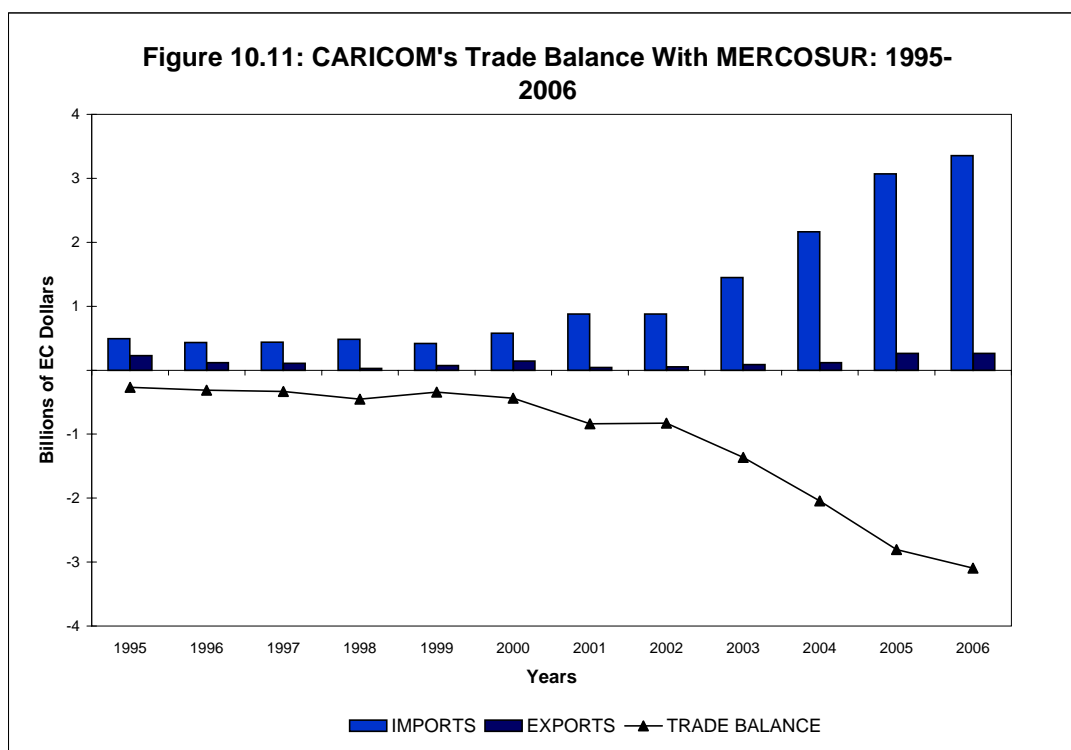
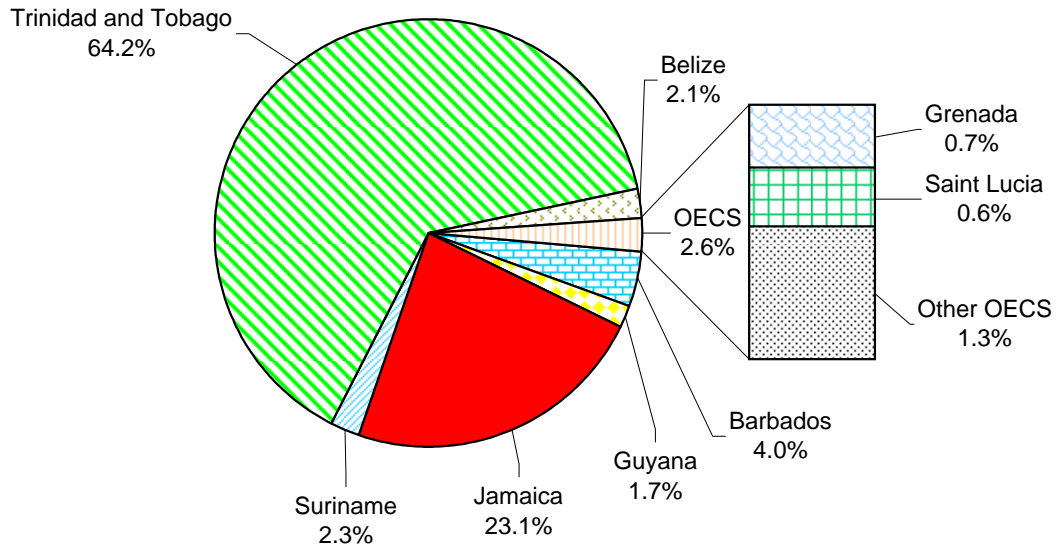

2006**

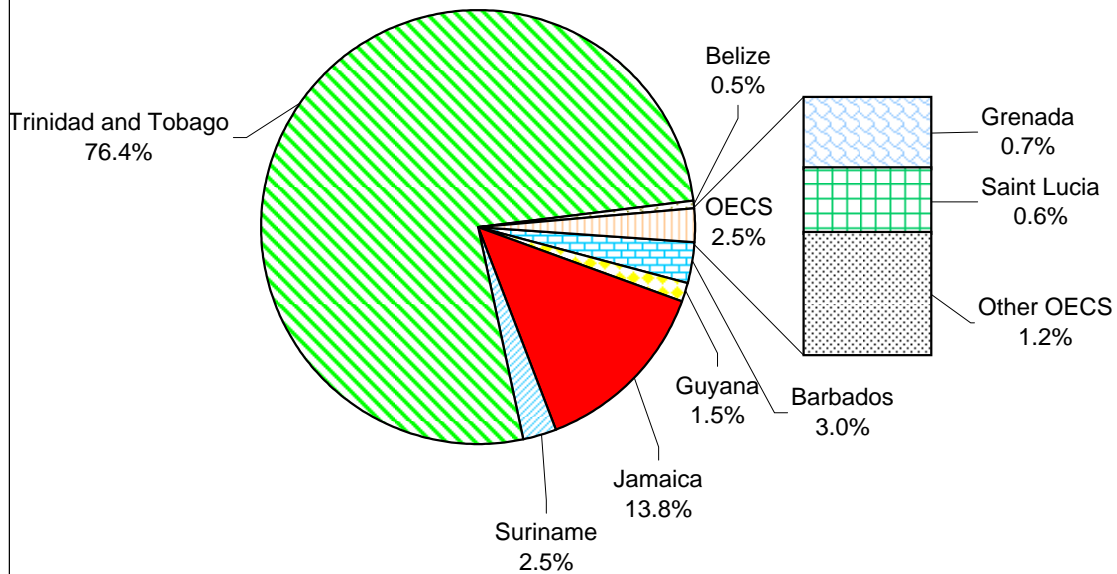

Figure 10.14: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Total Exports to MERCOSUR: 2001

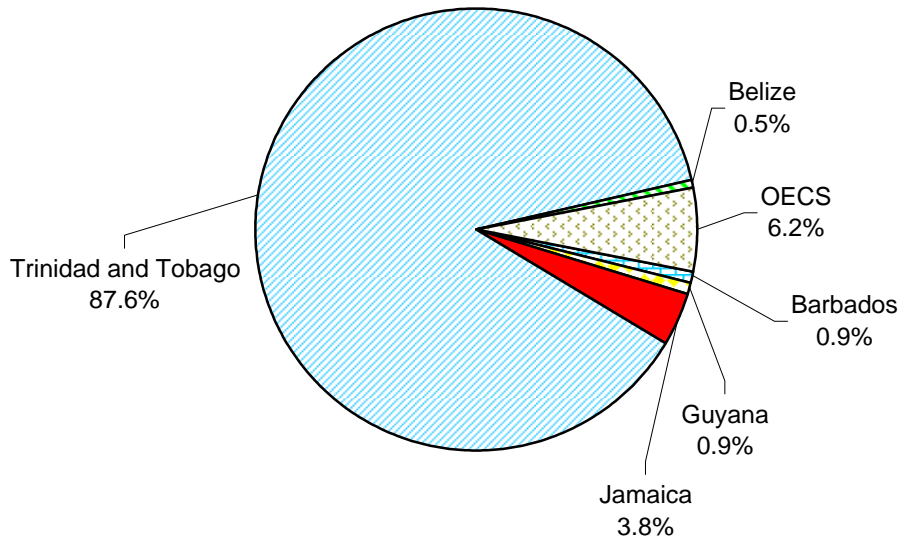


Figure 10.15: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Total Exports to MERCOSUR: 2006

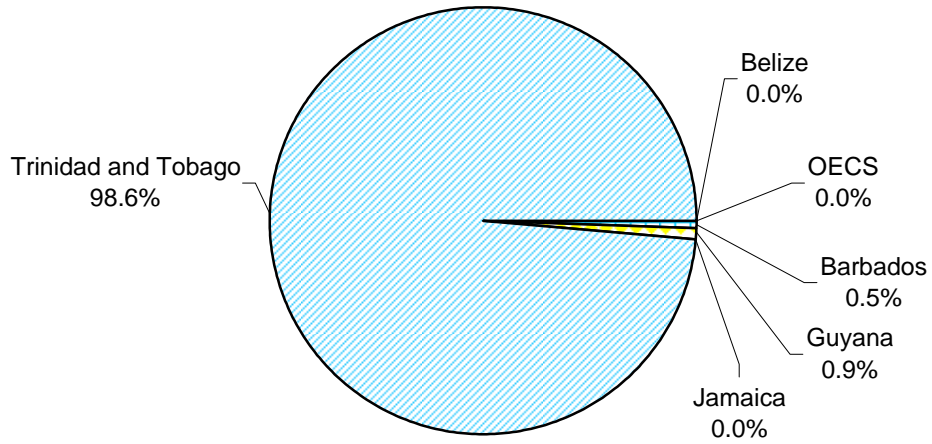

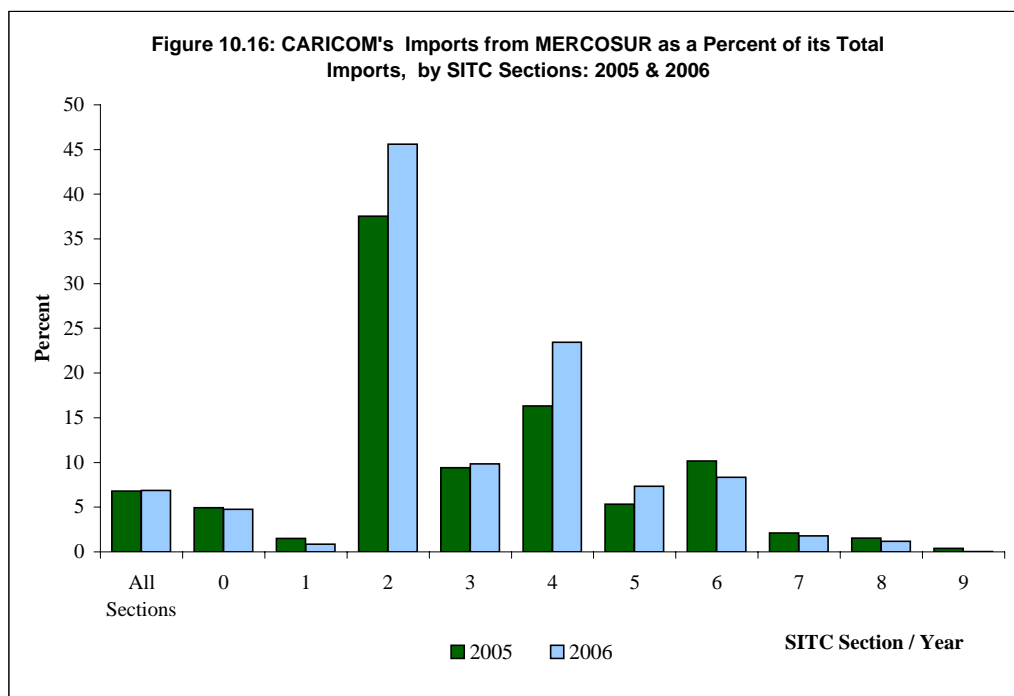

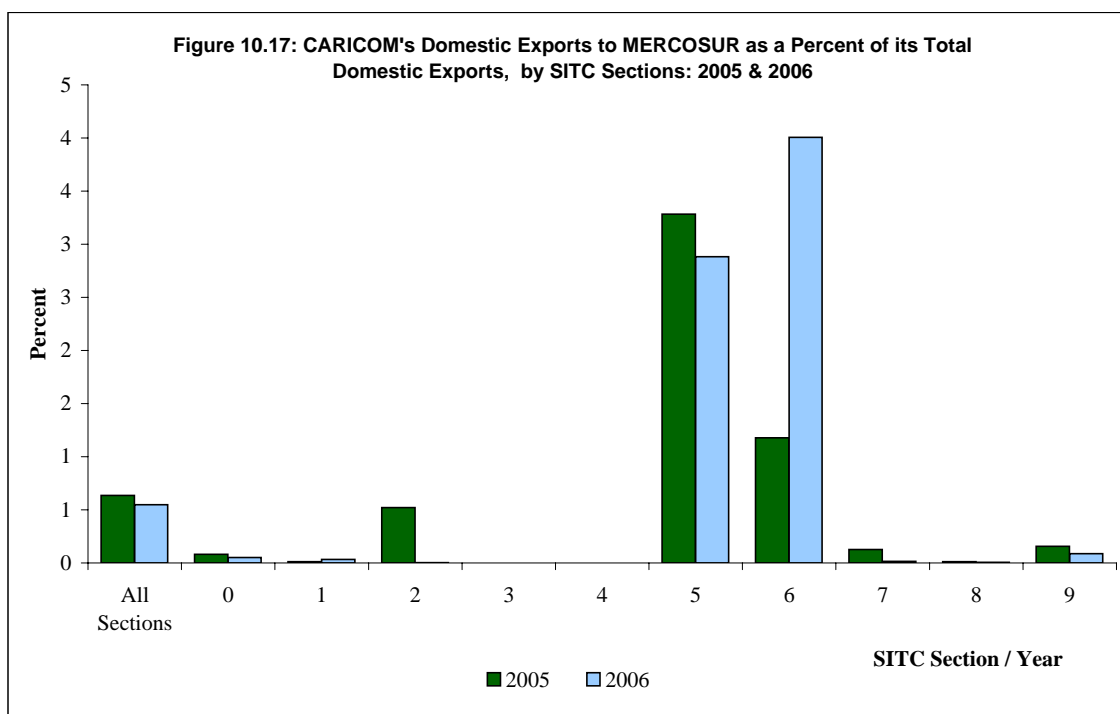
