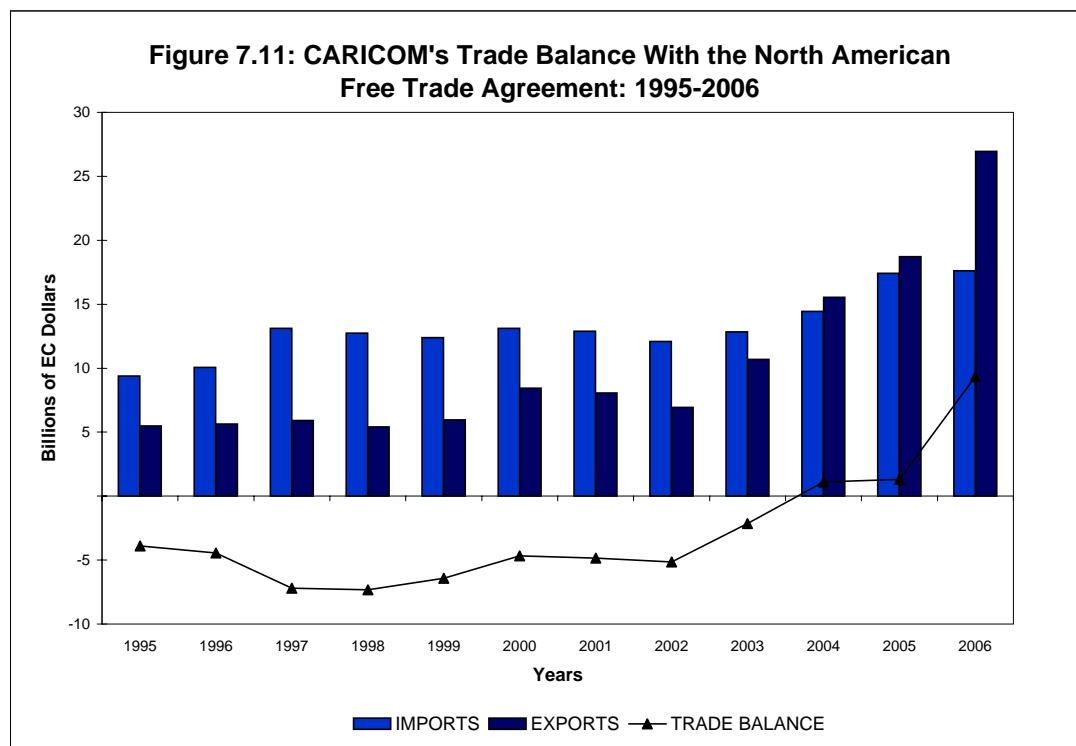

Figure 7.12: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Imports from NAFTA: 2001

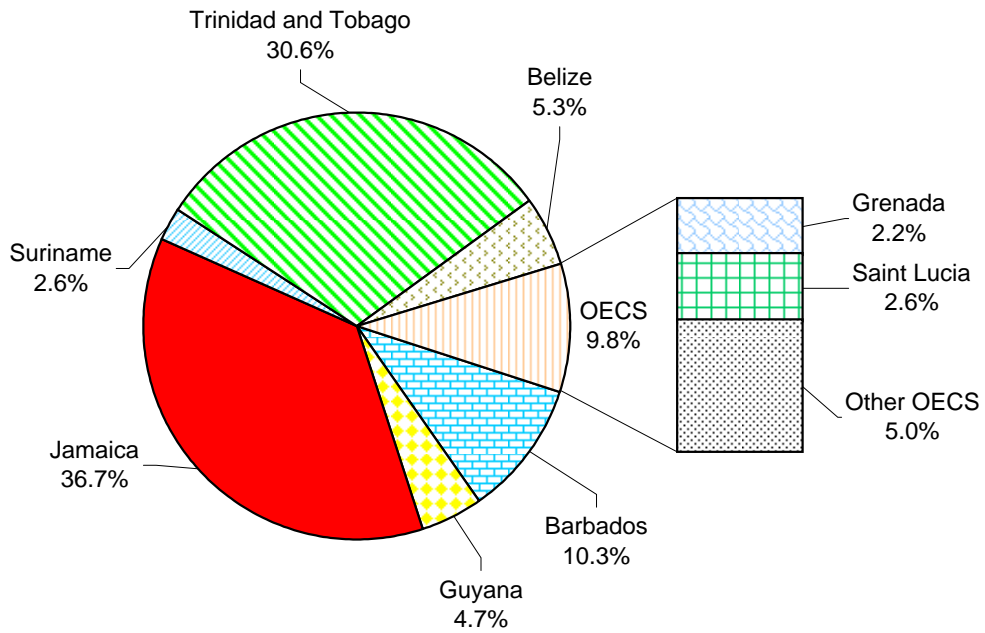


Figure 7.13: Percentage Distribution of CARICOM's Imports from NAFTA: 2006

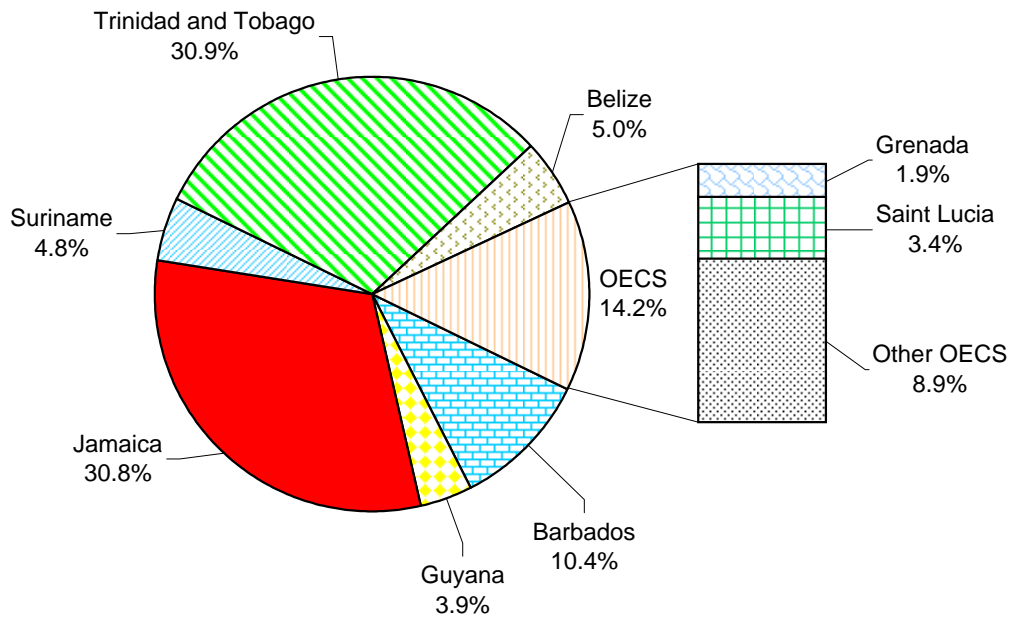


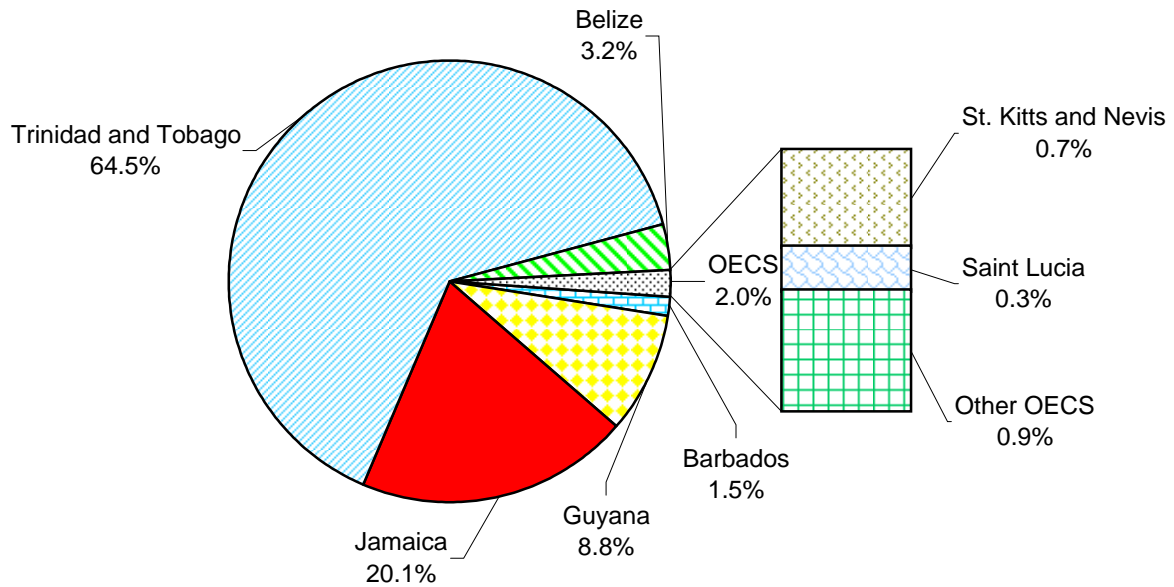

2006**

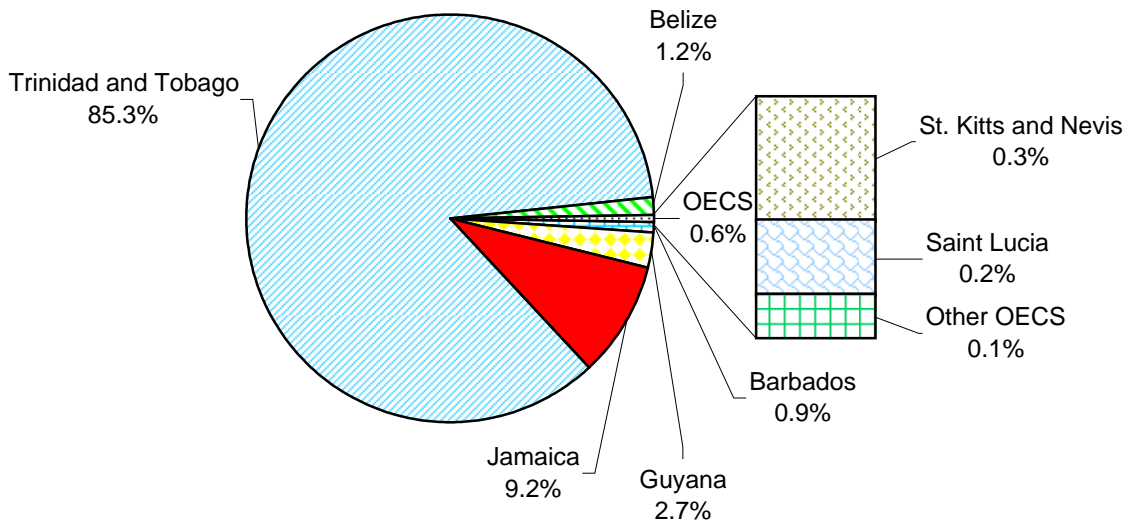

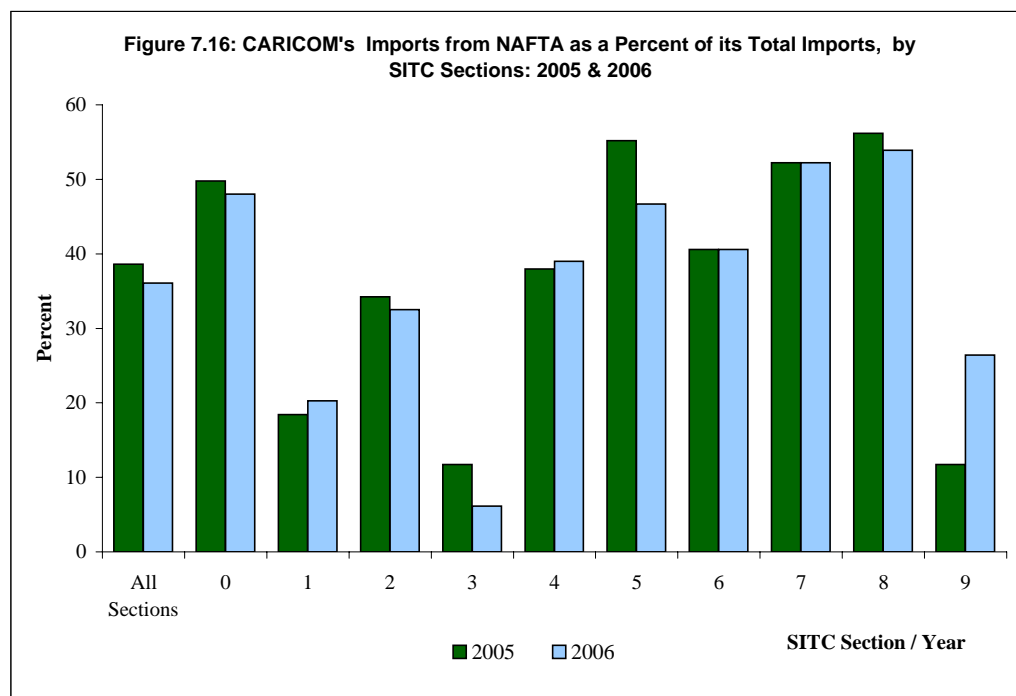

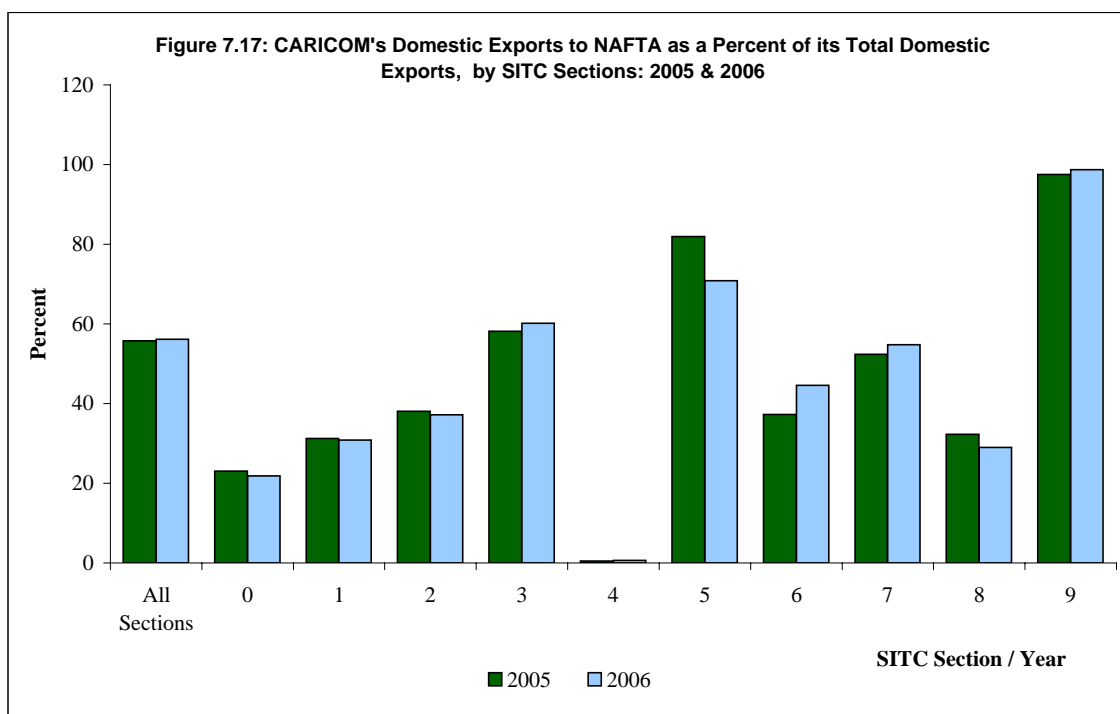
